Title: Statutory and Standing Committees

The District shall establish statutory committees that are required by the State of Iowa. Membership on such committees will be in accordance with appropriate State statutes. The administration shall recommend qualifying persons to the Board for membership on statutory committees. The Board shall approve all new members to committees annually or as otherwise provided by law.

In addition to statutory committees, the District shall maintain standing committees as may be necessary or advisable. The administration shall present annual status reports which shall include a review of the mission/purpose statements of the standing committees to the Board. The administration shall determine guidelines concerning selection of non-Board members and their terms, and make every effort to maintain gender balance and diversity. These guidelines should be based upon the concept of broad District and community representation. The administration may recognize volunteer committee members who are giving many hours of their time on behalf of the District.

All meetings of statutory and standing committees shall be held in accordance with the Open Meetings Law as applicable.

District statutory and standing committees shall include, but may not necessarily be limited to, the following committees:

Policy Review Committee
Teacher Quality Committee
Career Technical Education Advisory Council
