ALL: Parents must provide transportation to all Choice programs located in a school other than their zoned school. All elementary school choice selections are by random lottery (except CFA seats are filled by meeting eligibility requirements). Middle and High Schoolwide and Expanded Choice schools are also selected by random lottery. Middle and High School magnet students are selected based on the outcome of the selection process. Students are ranked based on points earned from teacher recommendations, writing samples, grades, test scores, and interviews. FAME, IB, STEAM, STEAM-M, CavPlex and iRED are lottery based programs. Palmetto Center for the Arts is by audition. Only students residing in Richland School District Two are eligible to apply.
