

Principal's Message

Dear Parents,

I hope everyone has had some relaxing time, family time, and vacation time! We are ready for a great year! We are excited to come back and welcome our students. Plattekill has been busy with the Capital Project which includes air conditioning in the cafeteria and gym, a new vestibule, and hallway ceilings. We have a new Greeter, therefore everyone MUST bring their photo ID.

Please note, on the first day of school your child will come home with the Student Handbook and Blue Folder. Please make sure to read through the Student Handbook, and complete the packet of required forms. Even though all students are eligible for a free breakfast or lunch daily during the 2024-2025 school year, if you do qualify for Free or Reduced Lunch, please complete the application, as you may be eligible for additional benefits. Applications should be completed and returned during the first two weeks of school.

For the 2024-2025 school year, all students are eligible for a free breakfast and lunch daily. There will be a charge for any items besides the meal. If a student chooses to buy a second breakfast and/or a second lunch on any given day, the price for lunch will be \$2.20, the price of Breakfast will be \$1.00. Milk prices in all schools will be \$.75 per carton.

Drop Off/Bus News & Cell Phone Policies

Establishing a consistent bus routine helps our drivers and children with their bus route. For our returning students, we need an updated bus note for the 2024-2025 school year. If your child is getting picked up/dropped off at a location other than your home, please write a note and include the following:

- Name of daycare within WCSD
- Address
- Phone number

Any time your information changes we need this in writing as well. Thank you for your cooperation to ensure we get your child home safely. Just a reminder for the first week of school our busses may arrive a bit later than usual to the bus stops. We are all getting used to the new routine.

Busses arrive around 8:30 a.m. at the school. The school day begins at 9:00 a.m. For safety reasons, please do not drop off students prior to 8:30 a.m. There will not be any supervision available prior to that time. Thank you for your cooperation.

Just a friendly reminder...school district policy states that cell phones should not be in school. However, we understand this is how you may communicate with your child before or after school. Therefore, the cell phone should be powered off and put away during the school day and on busses.

We have a new parent pick up time. Parents picking up their child(ren) from school will be at 3:00pm. We found 2:50pm was too early for the classrooms. Please be prompt.

All school doors are kept locked. Please have a photo ID ready. We have cameras throughout the building in the hallways and outside facing the school property. All windows have a protective film on them.



Please note afternoon pick up for all grades will be at 3:00 p.m. Be prepared to show ID.
