We are thrilled to announce that Science Exploration Day (SED) is back and invite your students to join us on Wednesday, March 19, 2025 at UB's North (Amherst) campus.

Now in its 35<sup>th</sup> year, the refreshed and revitalized Science Exploration Day is designed for STEM-oriented students from WNY High Schools. This unique event offers an immersive experience with leading STEM professionals and a variety of group interactive sessions and lab tours. Students can select their preferred session options.

Science Exploration Day will be held at the University at Buffalo, North Campus on Wednesday, March 19, 2025. Registration will begin at 8:30 a.m. Sessions will begin at 9:25 am and conclude at 1:00 p.m. This event is open to all local high schools. Please feel free to share this invitation with any fellow educators.

Interested schools may send up to 30 students. The cost will be a school registration fee of \$30.00 plus \$5.00 per student attending. Students will need to bring a box lunch. One teacher or other adult for each group of 15 or less students is required to accompany the students and will be assigned to supervise specific seminar sessions as well as provide general supervision for students.

Space will be limited to 800 students at SED '25. **Slots will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis.** If you wish to reserve space for your students, please use the QR code below to register by the priority deadline of November 17.
