Parents should drop off all medications for their child to our school nurse, Mrs. Saul. Nurse Saul will be available at MAMS on Wednesday, 8/28, and Thursday, 8/29, from 8:00-12:00 for dropping off medications. Additionally, the State requires students entering 6th grade to receive certain immunizations in order to attend school; without these immunizations, students may be excluded from attending school.
