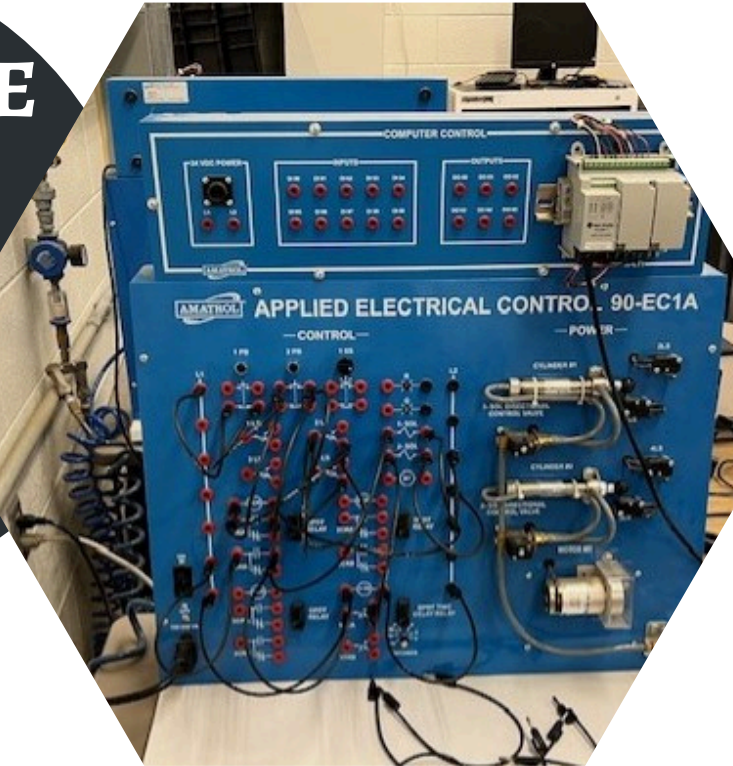

Course Description:

This is quick-paced, intermediate course for those with some electrical field experience (or for those that have completed the Basic Electricity Course). It introduces the 6 elements of control logic, limit switches, pneumatic control valves, relays, motor control, sequencing events, and Programmable Logic controllers. Students will spend time wiring up inputs, outputs, relays and the Allen-Bradley PLC to complete circuits. Towards the end of the class students will be expected to know how to program a basic sequence of events using the PLC program and the control board.
