

Greetings Williamston Families,

Michigan School Free Meals will begin at the start of the 2024-25 school year, providing state reimbursement to schools for every breakfast and lunch served to Michigan public school students who receive meals through their school's participation in the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) National School Breakfast and Lunch Program.

For every district that chooses to participate, pre-kindergarten through Grade 12 will receive one breakfast and one lunch per student, free of charge. The Michigan Department of Education (MDE) encourages all eligible districts to participate and prepare to support communities with program implementation.

MDE encourages parents/guardians to watch for the Child Nutrition and Education Benefits Application in their school enrollment packets and back-to-school information later this summer. Completed forms help districts access additional health and wellness services, before- and after-school academic and enrichment programs, guidance and college counselors, and fee waivers for various tests and applications. Please continue filling out the Child Nutrition and Education Benefit Application.

Williamston Community Schools will offer this program to all students who want to participate. Breakfast will be served in each school's cafeteria at the designated times.
