
STUDENT HEALTH

The superintendent will arrange for health services for all students. Such services shall include but are not limited to:

- A. The maintenance of student health records;
- B. The development of procedures at each building for the isolation and temporary care of students who become ill during the school day;
- C. Consulting services of a licensed healthcare provider and/or Registered Nurse Vision (both distance and near) and hearing screening; and
- D. Immunization records and screening.
