

Academic Tradition: MCHS is the district's highest-performing school on the CAASPP and CAST and it's one of the highest in the county for students meeting or exceeding standards in English, Math and Science. Additionally, our students have the highest SAT/ACT scores for comprehensive high schools in the county and score well above county and state averages. MCHS offers 17 AP courses in six subject areas, plus honors classes in every academic discipline. Our students have the highest AP exam participation rate in the district and, at 91%, the highest pass rate in the county. Additionally, almost 30% of our students take and succeed in one or more AP classes.

Advocacy Period: Students are paired with an advocacy teacher four days a week within our alternating block schedule. The 39-minute period allows students additional time beyond the classroom to meet with their teachers, receive tutoring, conference with counselors, attend College and Career Center events, and receive social and emotional support from trained adults on campus. **9th-grade advocacies also receive additional support in transitioning to high school and connecting with our Puma community through our Puma Peer Program**, consisting of juniors and seniors who help lead team-building activities and foster academic support. With an expanded leadership program and over 50 different clubs on campus, many of which further promote community service, students have a variety of ways to connect with each other and the larger community.

Competitive Athletic Teams, Award-Winning Performing Arts, and Award-Winning Culinary Arts Program:
