Each school district shall ensure that all students are provided with the opportunity to receive health screenings conducted by a school physician, school nurse, or other school personnel properly trained pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 6A:16–2.2(l). Please review the required annual health screenings that will be completed throughout the year:

- Height, Weight, Blood Pressure All students K-12
- Vision Grade 10
- **Hearing** Grade 11
- Scoliosis Grades 9 and 11

If at any time, the parent chooses to decline these screenings, a written request must be sent to the attention of the school nurse. Parents will be notified, in writing, of any screening results that are outside of the normal parameters. Looking forward to a Healthy, Happy School Year!
