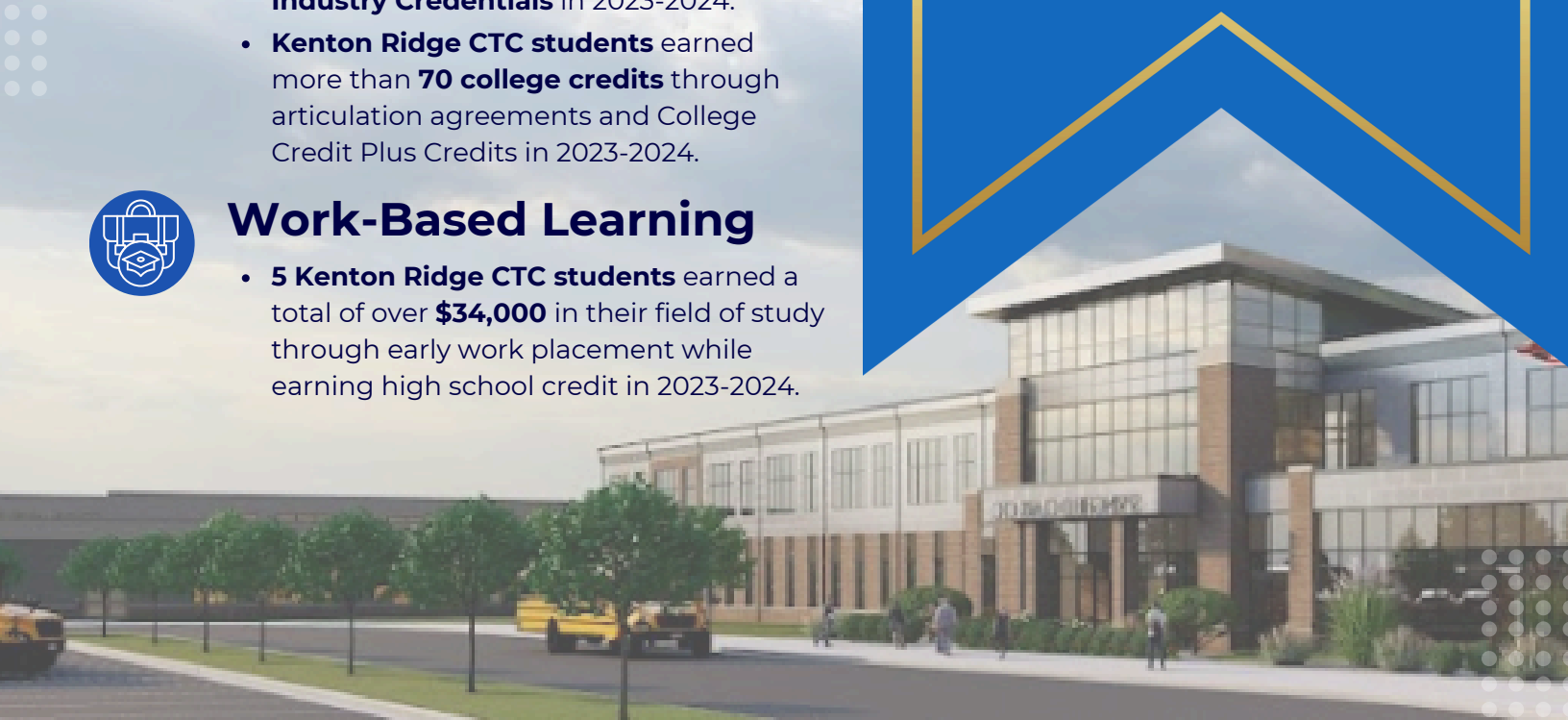

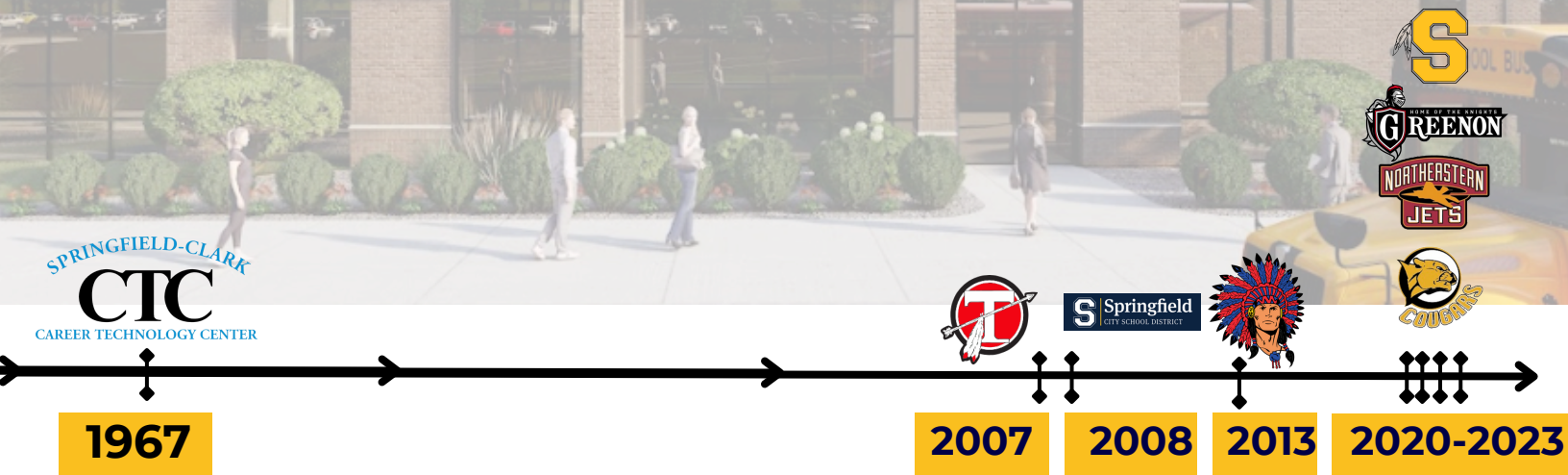

Career Technical Education (CTE) certificate holders can earn \$12,323 more than high school graduates five years after starting a program.



CTE graduates have a higher high school graduation rate than the overall United States graduation rate.

CAREER TECH FACTS

CTE graduates are just as likely as non-concentrators to earn a postsecondary degree or certificate.



The United States is projected to face a shortage of 6.5 million skilled workers over the next decade.

CTE graduates are more likely to be employed after high school than those who did not take CTE courses.
