The CrisisGo safety app will be used to inform you of school safety issues and to provide reliable, timely updates in the event of an emergency. The CrisisGo app is free to download by following the steps outlined in [this link](#). In addition, please encourage your children to download the Safe2SpeakUp app from the Apple Store or Google Play. They can sign in using Single Sign On (SSO) using their Google credentials. This will allow your child to receive alerts during a drill or real emergency along with important directions for safety in the event of a real emergency.
