1. Narrative description of the Prop 28 arts education program(s) funded. (2500 character limit).

For 2023-2024, Menlo Park City School District (MPCSD) received \$310,000 through Proposition 28 to enhance arts education for all students. The district launched a comprehensive Theater Program in all four schools, promoting creativity, confidence, and collaboration. The new theater program provides access for all students, fostering self-esteem, confidence, collaboration, communication skills, and creativity. The program also integrates other performing arts disciplines, such as dance, music, and visual arts, building on existing programs to create a dynamic and inclusive arts education environment. 80% of the funding is allocated to staffing, including a new District Theater Specialist position. This role supports the theater program and meets the requirement to use most of the funds for arts education staff. As we continue to build upon the theater program, we will have more expenditures to expend the funds from Prop 28. Proposition 28 enables MPCSD to create a dynamic arts education environment, enriching students' learning and fostering well-rounded development.
