BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education (the "Board") of the West Valley Central School District (the "District") is hereby authorized to purchase one (1) 65-passenger school bus and related equipment for use in the transportation program of the District, at an estimated maximum cost of \$109,180, and that the sum of \$109,180, being the aforesaid estimated maximum cost, or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be raised by the levy of a tax upon the taxable property of the District and collected in annual installments as provided by Section 416 of the Education Law, and, in anticipation of such tax, bonds or other obligations (including, without limitation, obligations arising under leases, lease/purchase contracts or installment purchase contracts having a term of not more than five years) of the District shall be issued or entered into in accordance with applicable provisions of New York State law.

Mr. Lawton introduced Ms. Ann O'Brien to present an overview of the 2016-2017 school budget with a slide presentation that summarized the revenues, budget and the budget components, Gap Elimination Adjustment, Property Tax Limit, Tax Levy, STAR, Property Tax Relief Credit, School Bus Purchase and Board Member election. Question and answer session followed.

The Budget Hearing concluded and the President of the Board of Education continued with the regular meeting.
