Homework Bill of Rights



Issues:

- Other schools allow homework during breaks
- Students staying up until midnight to complete assignments
- Assignments due at midnight due to new Canvas technology conflicting with old policies
- Confusion about homework policies

Proposed Changes:

- No homework during vacations and breaks
- Set due times to morning hours, before class starts(0 period/7 AM)
- Standardize homework policies district-wide

Why?:

- Enhance student well-being
- Ensure manageable homework load
- Students/Teachers on the same page of guidelines
- Clear Point of reference

Next Step:

Develop and present a comprehensive “Homework Bill of Rights” proposal with feedback from students and teachers
