

Title III at CASD

Title III funding provides At CASD, this funding concentrates on delivering language instruction educational programs to students who have a primary language other than English. This program is designed to improve the education of limited English proficient (LEP) children and youths by helping them learn English and meet challenging state academic content and student academic achievement standards. The program also provides enhanced instructional opportunities for immigrant children and youths.

Parent and Family Connections

We use our Title III funds to pay for two Parent and Family Liasons. These individuals work at all of our schools, offering as interpreters and supports for families at meetings and events. We use this funding to also purchase materials and supplies for events at the district and building level.

Professional Development

A portion of this funding is used for continued professional development and resources for district staff to deeper their learning of serving the ELL population in our district.
