

Title: Naming School Facilities

When a request to name or re-name a District facility, building, or specific area is made, a committee may be appointed to review the request. The Superintendent or designee will serve as chairperson of the committee. This committee may take into account the traditions of the facility, input from the community, the long-range impact, the intended use of the facility and other relevant factors. The District may consider recognizing an individual or organization as part of the name of a facility, building or specific area only to the extent allowed by applicable law as a result of how the building or facility is financed. The individual or organization's contribution of service, accomplishments and/or financial support will be considered.

Upon the receipt of a recommendation by the Superintendent, the Board will make a decision based upon the information presented and the long-term interests of the District.

Ordinarily a building or portion of a building will not be renamed unless its present name becomes inappropriate because of the community it serves or the program it houses. However, the Board reserves the right to change the name of a District facility, space, or specific area at any time if it is determined to be in the best interests of the District.
