- Austin High School is an architectural historical site and was given the Preservation Alliance of Minnesota Award in 1996.
- We offer **7 Advanced Placement courses** in Computer Science Principles, Calculus, Statistics and Functions, Biology, Physics, US History, Human Geography and Spanish Language/Culture.
- Students also have access to **14 concurrent enrollment courses** through Riverland Community College including Humanities, Composition, Speech, American Government, Microeconomics, US History, College Algebra, Pre-Calculus and Welding.
