1. Narrative description of the Prop 28 arts education program(s) funded. (2500 character limit).

Elementary schools spent 2023-24 Proposition 28 funds on art supplies, contracts for art programs for students, assemblies, and other activities in the domains of music, dance, theater, visual arts, and media arts. In grades 7-12, classes for students were added to middle and high schools in the areas of visual art, band, digital media arts, drama, and symphony. Secondary sites also made supplemental purchases of art supplies and musical instruments. These decisions were based on individual site needs and input from community partners.
