District SE Updates

- 1. BCE Newsletter Showcase: The BCE Parent Partners spearheaded an initiative to raise disability awareness on their campus during Disability Employment Awareness Month (October). This effort targeted both SPED and non-SPED students and families. It featured a bulletin board and a newsletter highlighting celebrities with disabilities, which was shared with all families. Other campuses are inspired to launch similar outreach projects and plan to exchange ideas to promote positive messages district-wide.
- 2. 60 Best Buddies @ CCE: Cedar Creek Elementary has 60 students participating in the Best Buddies program. Due to the large number of participants, the school has requested additional adult support to help the program grow. Events so far have included a Lemonade Social and a Monster Mash Bash. Feedback emphasized the importance of fostering meaningful relationships and creating calm spaces for students with sensory needs in a large group setting.
