2024-2025 SCHOOL YEAR UPDATE

PRESCHOOL EXPANSION FUNDING

Are you the parent of a preschool aged child and want a full-day, high-quality, preschool experience at no cost? Look no further because the Chesterfield Township School District is proud to announce we will begin full-day, high-quality, tuition free preschool for eligible students. In August, the Chesterfield Township School District submitted an application to the New Jersey Department of Education for special funding to support a tuition free, full-day preschool program. We are happy to report our application was approved and we plan to start the new preschool program during the 2024-2025 School Year.

The State funding is not a one-time award; it is funding that will continue to be provided by the State as long as we continue to have preschool students who attend. Not only will we be able to provide this opportunity here at Chesterfield Elementary School, the funding allows us to work with local preschools in the area for satellite classes so we are partnering with the iGo STEM Academy, our neighbor on Saddle Way. Please know that providing this free preschool program to all preschool-aged students is a process that will take several years to build. However, we plan to start the program this year with five (5) preschool classes - three (3) classes here at CES and two (2) classes at iGo STEM Academy. As per state law, the classrooms cannot exceed 15 students. Currently, we have close to 80 families who are interested in this opportunity, but we only have spots for 75 students. As a result, we will hold a lottery at our November Board of Education meeting.

SCHOOL SAFETY AND SECURITY

Hopefully everyone has had the opportunity to see our new security pass-thru box and window that were installed to the right of our front doors. The pass-thru box and window were part of a minor construction project this summer and further secure our building while providing visitors with meaningful interaction with our main office staff. When visiting the school, continue to approach the front doors and ring our doorbell. Depending on your need, you may be directed to the pass-thru box or window. Thank you in advance for working with us as we implement these new safety and security procedures.

As you know, the Chesterfield Township School District contracts with Tri-Shield Security for the services of security guards. The school always has one guard on duty, but that coverage is provided by two different guards. Security Guard David Walls worked with us last year and is the security guard in the district the majority of time. Our new security guard this year is Security Guard Mel Dixon. He will fill in on the days when Security Guard Walls is not here. We welcome Security Guard Dixon to our Chesterfield Elementary School Team.

CURRICULUM CORNER

We have been busy in the area of curriculum this summer. We will be entering the second year of the implementation of our new math curriculum. We were very pleased with the first year and we look forward to continuing our journey this year.

The New Jersey Department of Education recently revised the English Language Arts and Math standards, so our committees have worked over the summer to assure that our curriculum is well aligned to the new standards. These changes are not major changes in our curriculum, but a refinement of what we do. English Language Arts and Math standards are found in most of our other curriculum as well, so we have worked to update the standards in those documents as well.

Additionally, we have had teams working on revising our English as a Second Language, Enrichment, and Media Arts curricula. As a staff, we will continue to dive more deeply into these new standards and reflect on our instructional practice throughout this year. We are looking forward to a great year!
