School Board Meeting

Single Action Item

Request for Approval of Engineering Firm for the Roseburg High School Vo-Tech Building East Seismic Renovation

The district was awarded a seismic rehabilitation grant for the Roseburg High School Vo-Tech Building East in the amount of \$2,499,420 to provide seismic renovations in the east section of the career technical building, also known as the Vo-Tech building located on the Roseburg High School campus.

The Board approved the recommendation to retain the services of ZCS Engineering at a fee of \$255,500 to provide the engineering services for the RHS Vo-Tech Building East Seismic Renovation.

School Board Work Session

In January 2024, Douglas ESD Superintendent Analicia Nicholson presented the ESD's Local Service Plan for 2024-2025. The Board had requested some clarification and this work session is a follow up to that meeting.

Superintendent Nicholson was invited back to give the Board an opportunity to



become better informed about the services being provided as well as their effectiveness (return on investment) as required within our Strategic Plan). Districts within our ESD service area will be asked to vote on the 2025-26 Local Service Plan in February, 2025.

The mission of education service districts is to assist school districts and the Dept. of Education in achieving Oregon educational goals by providing equitable, high-quality, cost-effective and locally responsive educational services at regional levels.

For 2024-25, Douglas ESD receives Local Revenue of \$5.415 million and \$2.5 million of State School Fund (SSF). Ninety percent of total local and State School Fund revenue must be spent on services. ESDs shall provide regionalized core services to component school districts that include programs for children w/special needs; technology support; school improvement services; and administrative support services. Local Service Plan Goals include:

*Assisting districts in meeting state and federal law requirements;

- *Improve student learning;
- *Enhance quality of Instruction;
- *Enable districts and students to have equitable access to resources; and
- *Maximize operational and fiscal efficiencies for school districts.

The Board asked for details related to numbers of staff, credentials and compensation specific to services being provided to RPS, as well as the annual ESD Direct Support Report for 2022-2023. Superintendent Nicholson assured the Board that the requested information would be forthcoming no later than November 7th.
