Professional Positions

Teacher of the Deaf/Hard of Hearing (IU Wide) (start date as soon as possible)

Full-time (185-day) professional collective bargaining unit position with salary and benefits as per the collective bargaining agreement. Requires valid certification in PA as a Teacher of Hearing Impaired with strong preference for fluency in American Sign Language. **General Responsibilities include (but are not limited to):** providing direct service to eligible students to support educational attainment and successful communication for students who are deaf or hard of hearing; writing IEPs and communication plans; and collaborating with educational audiologists and school staff regarding amplification in the daily routine. Position also includes coordinating with RIU6, other service providers, families, and school district personnel to meet the needs of each individual learner, providing the best care, safety, welfare, and security of students.

Early Intervention Service Coordinator (East Region) (anticipated start January 2, 2025)

Full-time (185 day) professional collective bargaining unit position with salary and benefits as per the collective bargaining agreement. Requires PA Teaching Certification in Special Education and a minimum of five years teaching experience with strong preference to preschool age experience; valid driver license; and all appropriate clearances **General Responsibilities include (but are not limited to):** developing and coordinating child and family linkages with infant/toddler programs upon entry to preschool and with school districts upon exit from preschool services; assisting children and families with resources and education regarding local services that may benefit the family; monitoring EI program data; maintaining documentation of compliance with mandates of IDEA and Chapter 14; and coordinating all aspects of EI to meet the needs of each individual learner, proving the best care, safety, welfare, and security of students. Position also requires walking, standing, stooping, lifting approximately 20 pounds, with occasional lifting of equipment and materials weighing up to 40 pounds.

Mental Health Specialist (IU Wide) (posted 9/5/2024)

Full-time (185-day) professional collective bargaining unit position with salary and benefits as per the collective bargaining agreement. Requires a Master's Degree in social work, counseling, or related field and valid certification/licensure in PA as a Licensed Professional Counselor, Licensed Social Worker, Licensed Clinical Social Worker, or PDE certification as a School Social Worker. Also requires a working knowledge of mental health disorders, behaviors, treatment modalities, crisis intervention, community service agencies, and excellent interpersonal and communication skills. Experience working with children within the public school setting preferred. **General Responsibilities include (but are not limited to):** planning and implementing strategies to assist students in crisis; conducting individual and group counseling sessions for special needs students; developing positive relationships with students, families, schools and agencies. Position also includes coordinating with RIU6, service providers, families, and school district personnel to meet the needs of each individual learner, providing the best care, safety, welfare, and security of students.

Support Positions

Classroom Paraprofessional (Clarion Partial Program at Clarion Psychiatric Center) (anticipated start January 2, 2025)

Full-time position (184 days). Requires valid high school diploma and Acts 34, 114, and 151 clearances, highly qualified certification preferred. This is a collective bargaining unit position with competitive wages and excellent benefits. **General Responsibilities include (but are not limited to):** providing the best care, safety, welfare, and security for our students; providing assistance to the instructional staff in the classroom with a focus on your assigned students/tasks; and coordinating with RIU6 and school district personnel to meet the needs of the individual learner.
