

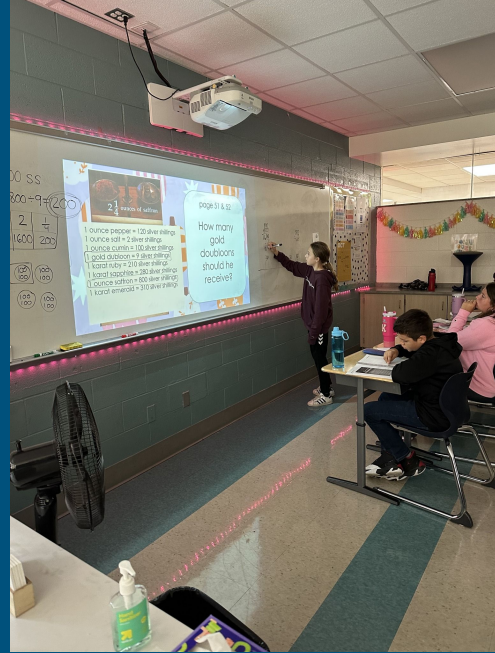

Scenes from around Cooper Upper Elementary! Music class with violins; some math practice and book fair fun!

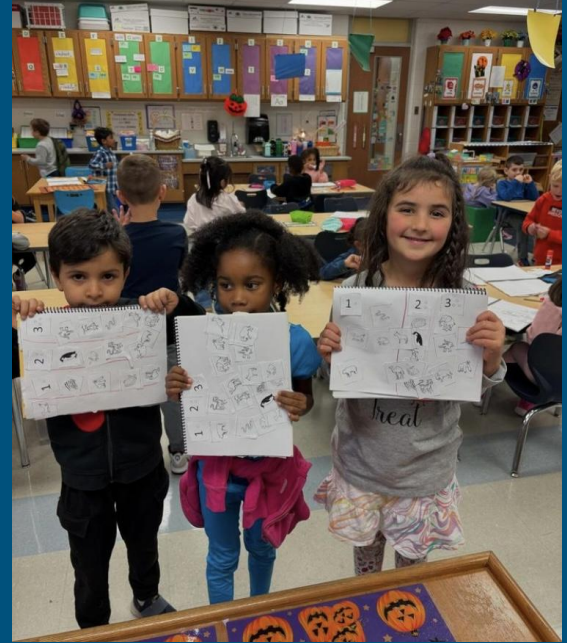
