November 1st : Solemnity of All Saints (Friday)

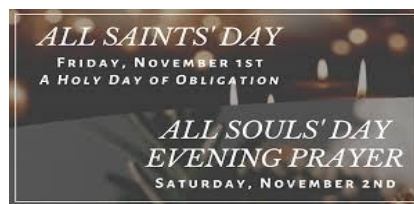
