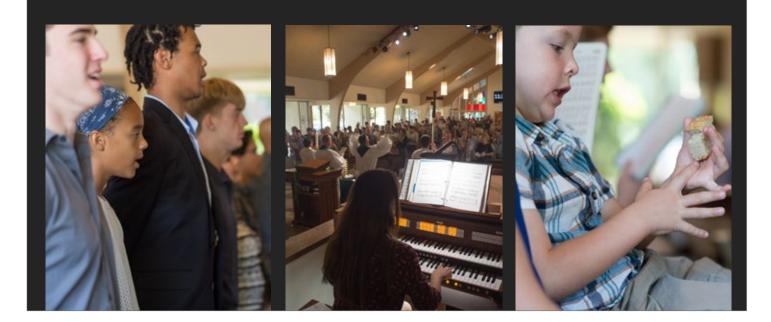

Welcome to Trinity Athletics

hank you for supporting Trinity Athletics. We have a proud tradition of athletic excellence at Trinity Classical Academy and teams strive for integrity, camaraderie and victory.

When considering classical Christian Education, one might think of the study of the great classical works of literature, conversations in Latin, or perhaps the beauty of math and art. What role does athletics have in classical Christian Education? Is it just passing to an open receiver? Running across the finish line? Bump, set, spike? At Trinity we believe that athletics is a worthy reflection of the classical pursuits of Grammar, Logic and Rhetoric.

Learning the basics of any sport is the Grammar. What are the rules? What are the positions? What are the skills needed? It takes years to hone athletic skills. Repetitive drills, practice over and over again, training and fine motor development until execution becomes habitual. How can an athlete run faster? Weight training, speed drills, choosing the right equipment and the right regimens. All of these combine to grow the athlete into an effective participant, much like the Grammar phase of learning.

Athletics requires thinking, an excellent way to reflect the logic phase of learning. In some sports it is memorizing, understanding and applying plays. In others, it's following the course. In others, it is knowing which swing or pitch or scheme to use for each situation. There is order and integration of the facts and skills that one has learned. How does the way an athlete plays affect the other teammates on the field? There is testing of methodologies and much trial and error where logical conclusions are reached about what works for a team and what doesn't. This is where we see athletes putting into practice the skills they have learned and starting to experiment with their skills and what they can accomplish with what they have learned.



Finally, sports requires communication and strategy, just like the rhetoric phase of a classical Christian Education. An athlete seeks to not only implement their skills in a sporting contest, but to help their teammates improve and work together. There is strategy involved in studying the opposing team, learning their strengths and weaknesses and how to challenge them during the contest. It is a look with the eyes to a teammate to have them make a particular move without the need for words. It is also learning concepts as opposed to specific plays, thus taking competition to a new level.

The skills are the foundation, the implementation is the second step, and learning strategy and concepts is the final step. This process mirrors well the methodology of classical training.

Holding athletics together is the foundation and bond fostered by Christ on a team. Teammates care for one another beyond the field, court or track. They develop deeps bonds as the Lord weaves them together in the crucible of competition. They care for one another through the ups and downs, the struggles and the triumphs that come with athletic competition.

Thank you for being with us for today's contest and may the Lord bless this time and all that is learned from it.

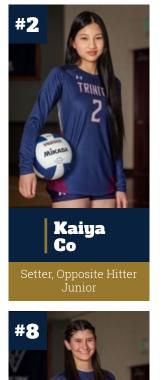

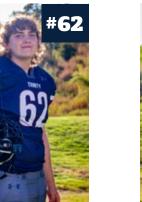

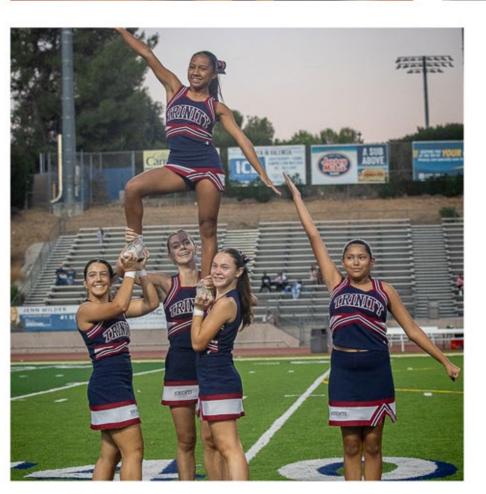

James Brooks Class of 2012 Football, Basketball Baseball

James Brooks, was a standout player in football, basketball and baseball and named Male Athlete of the Year twice and Male Scholar Athlete of the year in 2012. His numerous single-season achievements include 24 receiving touchdowns in football; in basketball, he had 276 rebounds and 116 blocks, with a career records of 213 blocks.. James was recruited to play football at Hillsdale College and also played basketball at Kings College.

Kaeli Massetto Dakota Prochnow Class of 2012 Class of 2013

Volleyball, Soccer Softball

A three-sport athlete, Kaeli Massetto, was the recipient of Trinity's Female Athlete of the Year for 3 consecutive years, where she was a leader in volleyball, soccer and most notably softball. She was awarded the Omega League MVP twice and receieved All CIF honors twice. She holds career records in softball of 16 home runs and 54 RBI's. Kaeli attended Norhtwest Christian University and played softball.

Dakota Prochnow was a mainstay in both football and baseball at Trinity. He earned Male Athlete of the Year in 2012 and 2013 as well as All-CIF recognition and CIF Offensive Player of the Year in football in 2012. His remarkable career records at Trinity include 26 interceptions in football and 98 RBIs and 75 stolen bases in baseball. Dakota went on to play football at Benedictine College in Kansas.
