Middle School Six-Period Day Schedule (2025-2026), Deputy Superintendent Mrs. Ondrea Reed

Mrs. Reed outlined an upcoming change to the middle school schedule for the 2025-26 school year. Key points from her presentation included: Transition from a 7-period schedule, which currently includes two English Language Arts periods, to a 6-period schedule with a single English class; all classes will be approximately 55 minutes long, ensuring equal time for each subject; development of new bell schedules by school leadership teams, while maintaining existing start and end times; and ongoing collaboration among teachers to effectively prepare for the new schedule.
