AP - All students taking an AP class(es) must be joined to their course in My AP Classroom and must complete Exam Registration by Friday 11/1. To indicate an intention to test, students click on the "Register for Exam" button on each class tile and select either "Confirm" or "No". The payment window will be open from Monday November 4th through Wednesday November 13th and fees can be paid in cash, a singular personal check for the household or money order made out to "BHS AP", or using a credit/debit Visa, Mastercard, or Discover on the [BHS Payment Portal](#).
