EMERGENCY NOTIFICATION ACTIONS



SECURE PERIMETER

Get Inside. Lock Outside Doors.

STUDENTS

Return to inside of building.
Do business as usual.

ADULTS

Bring everyone indoors and lock outside doors.
Increase situational awareness.
Account for students and adults.
Do business as usual.



LOCKDOWN (AVOID, DENY, DEFEND)

Locks, Lights, Out of Sight.

STUDENTS

Move away from sight.
Be silent.
Do not open the door.

ADULTS

Recover students from hallway if possible and lock the classroom door.
Turn off lights and move away from sight.
Maintain silence.
Do not open the door.
Prepare to evade or defend.



EVACUATE

Evacuate to Specified Location.

STUDENTS

Leave stuff behind if required.
Bring your phone if possible.
Follow instructions.

ADULTS

Lead students to Evacuation Location.
Account for students and adults.
Notify if you have missing, extra, or injured students or adults.



SHELTER

Hazard and Safety Strategy.

STUDENTS

Use appropriate *safety strategy* for hazard.

ADULTS

Lead safety strategy.
Account for students and adults.
Notify if you have missing, extra, or injured students or adults.

HAZARD SAFETY STRATEGY

TORNADO

Evacuate to Shelter Area.

HAZMAT

Seal the Room.

EARTHQUAKE

Drop, Cover and Hold.

FLOOD

Get to Higher Ground.



ACTIVATE RESPONSE PROTOCOLS

Make Announcement

Intercom • Two-Way Radio • Phone Landline

Secure Perimeter, Lockdown, Evacuate, Shelter.



NOTIFY FIRST RESPONDERS

Call 911

Call 911 immediately, do not hesitate or second guess calling.

Alert Your SRO

Notify your SRO via two-way radio/cell phone.



PUSH TO TALK+ (ALERT LEVELS)

Notify the CO Emergency Response Team

Identify the appropriate Level and notify the CO Emergency Response Team.

Notify Your Feeder Pattern

If necessary, notify your feeder pattern.



EXTERNAL COMMUNICATIONS

Send All Call Messages to Parents/Community

Before sending any all call message, email or social media update, check and verify with Public Relations and Central Office.

Update Your Contact Information

Contact Public Relations with updates and information that can be communicated through social media. Ensure all your contact information is up to date.

PUSH TO TALK+

ALERT LEVELS

LEVEL I

Heightened Sense of Alert/Standby - Campus not impacted.

LEVEL II

Response Action Required.

LEVEL III

Imminent Danger - Immediate Action Required.

DRILL

Practice Drill - Pay attention for further instructions.
