My name is Mike Starkey and I am President of the 2019-2020 BHS Athletic Boosters. **I am really excited about what we can do for all our athletes through the Boosters.** It will take various types of support from our community to accomplish the goals we have set for helping our athletes. Some types of support are 1) being "there" for our athletes by attending the functions and games, 2) becoming members of the Boosters [Chieftain Club], 3) being active participants in fundraisers (whether you are someone helping with the fund raiser or being a sponsor or consumer of that fund raiser).

One of the fund raisers of the Athletic Boosters is the Chieftain Club membership. The funds raised through the membership fees are used for educational scholarships and improvements for the teams such as purchasing new equipment, updating the facilities, etc. **I am asking you to join me in supporting our athletes.** Last year our membership total 102 in the Chieftain Club, but we would like to see the support rise to 200 members. I would like to personally thank each of the 2018-2019 members for their support and ask that you consider renewing your membership for the 2019-2020 school year.

We are continuing with multiple membership options for the Chieftain Club, which we have done since 2015. Each member will still be listed in the program but now by your sponsor level. The first level will be the **Bronze** level for a **\$50** donation. In addition to your name in the program you will also receive a Chieftain Club window cling. The **Silver** level (**\$100** donation) will receive the same as the Bronze plus a yard sign. The **Gold** level (**\$250** donation) will receive the same as the Silver plus embroidered Chieftain Club apparel. **Please join this year and consider becoming a Gold or Silver level member.**

In addition, we were able to donate nearly \$34,000 to the athletic department for equipment and other needs. We increased advertising in the fall & winter sports programs, hosted another playoff football game, and held another successful March Madness fundraiser.

We have big plans in 2019. We plan to expand food choices at the stadium concession stand, bring back the shooting of the cannon after Chieftain scores at home football games, and we are having a major fundraising event in February.

1. To begin the process, go the website and “sign in” or “create an account” if you have not set up an online account yet.
2. Complete the requested information: a) email, b) create password, then c) select store location by entering the zip code or address. Once store appears, click “create account”.
3. Enter your card number or your last name and follow the prompts.
4. Choose organization to enroll for rewards. Click on “Search” and look for Bellefontaine Booster Club (Athletic) or enter code #81557. Click “enroll” and you will receive a confirmation message updating your account summary. It takes approximately 10 days for the Community Rewards total to begin displaying on your receipt.
5. If you are already registered, click on “*View Your Rewards Details*” to see what organization(s) you are signed up for and it will tell you the last quarter’s donation from your purchases.
