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Celina High School: Follow St. Rt. 33 West to Rt. 29 West to Celina. Turn right on Grand Lake Avenue, one block, turn LEFT on Livingston to the Field House.

Dayton Stebbins: Follow St. Rt. 68 South. Take the 68 bypass to I-70. Follow I-70 to Rt. 4. Take Rt.4 to Harshman Rd turn RIGHT. High School is located at 1900 Harshman Rd.

Graham High School: Take St. Rt 68 South to Urbana. Head East on St Rt 36

Greenon High School: Follow St. Rt. 68 South past I-70. Turn RIGHT on Fairfield Pike. Turn RIGHT on Rocky Point Road. Follow to school.

Indian Lake High School: Follow St. Rt. 33 West. Turn LEFT on St. Rt. 274 past Huntsville exit; School is at the intersection of St. Rt. 274 and St. Rt. 235.

Kenton Ridge High School: Follow St. Rt. 68 South. Turn LEFT on St. Rt. 334 Turn LEFT on Middle-Urbana Road. High School is approximately 1/2 miles on the RIGHT.

Kenton High School: Take St. Rt 68 North to Kenton. Turn right at W Columbus St. Turn LEFT at Hester St. Hester St becomes Sumnmit St. Turn RIGHT on Harding Ave.

Marysville High School: Follow St. Rt. 33 East to St. Rt. 31. Exit to the RIGHT towards Marysville. Go to first light, turn RIGH (Middle School in on the corner). Follow road back to High School.

Northwestern High School: Follow St. Rt. 68 South. Take bypass 68 South to RIGHT on St. Rt. 41. School will be on RIGHT about 8 miles.

Sidney High School: Take St. Rt. 47 West to Sidney. Go to 4th Avenue. Turn LEFT; go to first light, turn LEFT on Campbell; High School is on RIGHT;

Springfield Shawnee High School: Follow St. Rt. 68 South; take 68 bypass around Springfield. Take I-70 East exit to the St. Rt. 72 exit. At the end of the ramp turn LEFT. Follow Rt. 72 for approximately 2 miles. Turn LEFT on Possum Run Road. Follow to High School.

Tecumseh High School: Follow St. Rt. 47 to St. Rt. 235. Go through New Carlisle to St. Rt. 40. Turn LEFT on St. Rt. 40. High School is about 5 miles on the LEFT.

Tippecanoe High School: Follow St. Rt. 47 to I-75 at Sidney. Take I-75 South to Tipp City Exit (St. Rt. 571), turn LEFT on St. Rt. 571. Go to Hyatt St (Dairy Queen on corner) and turn LEFT, school will be on the left.

Urbana: Take St Rt 68 south into Urbana.

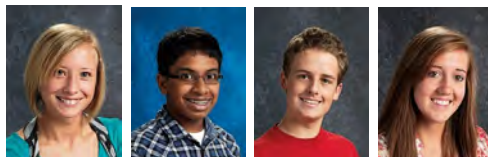
Wapakoneta High School: Follow St. Rt. 33 NW to Wapakoneta. Just before you reach the I-75 ramp there is RR crossing. Before the RR crossing a road angles to the right; follow this over I-75 into Wapakoneta. Follow Bellefontaine St. into town; Turn RIGHT on Water St. Turn LEFT onto Redskin Trail. Follow this to the High School.
