The 120 member "Pride of the Tribe" will be presenting a program entitled "1968", show-casing music and events that took place on that pivotal year in history. This will be an updated version from the show used in Fall of 2007 and is one of Mr. Antram's favorite shows in which he directed. The show opens with an exciting rendition of "Aquarius", a theme from the Broadway musical "Hair", which opened in 1968. This is followed by a medley of "Sunshine of Your Love" and "Born to Be Wild", rebellious melodies popular that year. The third movement is an intriguing medley of inspirational songs from various causes of the time; "We Shall Overcome" which features a brass quintet including Matt Baughman, Kayla Calton, Courtney Chervenak, Gage Easton, and Adam Verbsky; "Abraham, Martin and John" featuring the Woodwind Section; and "Butterfield's Lullaby" (Taps) with soloists Gage Easton and Parker Neeld. The closer celebrates freedom and includes "People Got to Be Free" and "Let the Sunshine In". The various movements are accompanied by powerful banners that help visualize important events that took place in 1968, including the assassinations of Martin Luther King Jr. and Robert Kennedy and public reaction to the Vietnam War.

*January 2006, the BHS Symphonic Band was a guest performance group for the Bowling Green State University Band Reading Clinic.

*November 2010, the band marched for the sixth time in the Philadelphia Thanksgiving Day Parade and toured New York City.


