

# Roseville High School Student Conduct Policy (9<sup>th</sup> thru 11<sup>th</sup> grade)

Student Conduct exists as a means of helping students understand that diminishing academic effort, poor school attendance, inappropriate behavior, or bad decision making can result in loss of privileges or failing to earn a high school diploma and ultimately missing the graduation ceremony.

**Roseville High School Student Conduct:** Student performance will be reviewed in the areas of **academics and behavior**. Student Conduct is reviewed at the conclusion of **every** quarter grading period. Failure to meet appropriate standards in any one of these areas will result in loss of privileges including extra-curricular activities.

Students are placed on **Student Conduct** for one or more of the following reasons:

## **ACADEMICS**

- ◆ Received two or more “F” grades and/or Incompletes in any course at the conclusion of a quarter grading period (final grade).

## **ATTENDANCE**

- ◆ 16 or more **UNVERIFIED** or **UNEXCUSED** period absences during any quarter grading period.
- ◆ 10 or more total unexcused **TARDIES** during any quarter grading period.

## **DISCIPLINE**

- ◆ Any **SUSPENSION** from the regular school day for any offense during the school year.

## **What does this mean?**

Students on **Student Conduct** will **not be allowed to participate or attend** any school related extracurricular activity. **This currently excludes athletics and athletic events.**

Student Conduct placement applies to the current quarter grading period.

- ◆ **Example: Student earns an “F” in two classes during 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter. Student is placed on Student Conduct for the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter grading period.**

### **How students may be removed from Student Conduct:**

- 1. Students may EARN their way off Student Conduct** by noticeably improving their grades, and discipline over the next quarter.
- 2. Students may APPEAL in writing** to their Assistant Principal due to a situation beyond the student’s control or with a compelling explanation. A compelling explanation or situation is defined as an unforeseeable, unavoidable and uncorrectable act, condition or event that may have caused the student to be placed on Student Conduct for poor academics, or disciplinary action.

Appeal forms may be downloaded from the RHS Website or can be picked up from the Assistant Principals’ Secretary or Student Services. **The deadline to turn in appeals is noted on the Student/Parent Notification Letter (reverse side).**

## **ATTENTION STUDENTS AND PARENTS**

Students that earn two or more F's and/or Incompletes, attained 16 or more unexcused or unverified period absences and/or 10+ tardies, and/or have been suspended during the previous quarter WILL be placed on Senior Conduct.

Activities that will be impacted (but not limited to), are as follows:

- Homecoming Dance
- Homecoming Court
- Rally Participlation
- Casaba Dance
- Casaba Court
- Junior Prom
- Senior Ball
- Senior Day Graduation Ceremony (depending on the conduct circumstances)
- Other RJUHSD School Dances and/or other outside RJUHSD School District Dances, where a bid will need to be approved by RHS Administration.

Throughout the school year, Roseville High School will be dedicated to recognizing the continuous improvement of students academics, attendance, and social behavior. We are committed to holding high, but reasonable standards and expectations of our students as well as recognizing and rewarding those that have met these expectations and standards.
