The City of Medford, led by its Engineering Office, is accepting sealed bids from firms for Gourley & Dwyer Circle Improvements.

The work in this Contract includes, but is not limited to:

- Pavement rehabilitation including micromilling and overlay as well as sections of pavement reclamation
- Installation of intermediate, leveling and surface course superpave material
- Installation of new granite curb; removal and resetting of granite curb
- Structure adjustments as required
- Removal and replacement of cement concrete sidewalk
- Installation of cement concrete wheelchair ramps
- Installation of pavement markings and traffic signing
- Safety controls and signing for construction operations
- All other incidental items included in the contract documents

Bids shall be on a Unit Price Basis

MassDOT prequalification of contractors with the class of work as Highway Construction, for the project with an estimated value of \$1,146,684.50.

This project is being Electronically Bid (E-Bid). All bids shall be submitted online to www.BidNetDirect.com prior to **November 14, 2024, by 11:00 AM**. Each Bid shall be submitted in accordance with the Instruction to Bidders and shall be accompanied by a Bid Security in form of a bid bond, or certified check, and/or a treasurer's or cashier's check issued by a responsible bank or trust company in the amount of five (5) percent of the bid and fifty (50) percent payment bond. It is the responsibility of prospective proposers to check

www.BidNetDirect.com for new information via any addenda to this solicitation. Any addenda issued will be emailed to all plan holders registered with BidNetDirect.

Minimum Wage Rates as determined by the Commissioner of the Department of Labor and Workforce Development under the provision of Massachusetts General Law (M.G.L.) c. 149, § 26 to 27D, as amended, apply to this project. It is the responsibility of the Bidder, before bid opening, to request, if necessary, any additional information on Minimum Wage Rates for those tradespeople who may be employed for the proposed work under this Contract.

The bidding and Award of this Contract will be under the provisions of M.G.L. c. 30, § 39M. The City of Medford reserves the right to accept any bid, in whole or in part, to reject any/or all bids and to waive minor irregularities and/or informalities as it deems to be in the best interest of the City.
