Our students at DPS have been working very hard during the month! The students at DPS began reading music notation and have been playing rhythms on instruments like the rhythm sticks and egg shakers. They have also started to explore their singing voices with tonic and dominant harmonic patterns, and have been learning Autumn songs. Our 1st and 2nd graders recently learned the difference between major and minor. Have them tell you the difference between major and minor!

#### 9th - 12th Grade Band/Drumline/Music Exploratory Class | Ms. Johnson | johnsonj@dansvillecsd.org


