

Seal of Biliteracy 2024-24

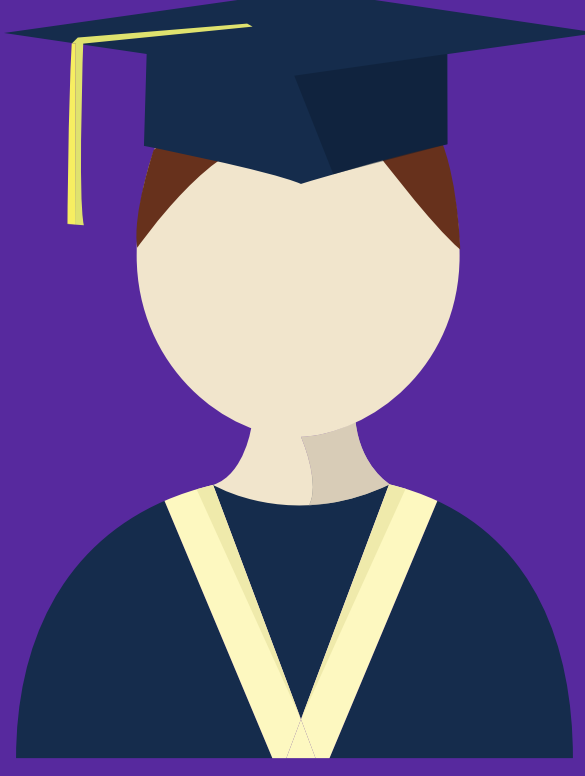
By the numbers

2023-2024 was District 86's eighth year implementing the Illinois State Seal of Biliteracy Program.

The Seal of Biliteracy is an award given in recognition of students who have studied and attained proficiency in two or more languages by their high school graduation.

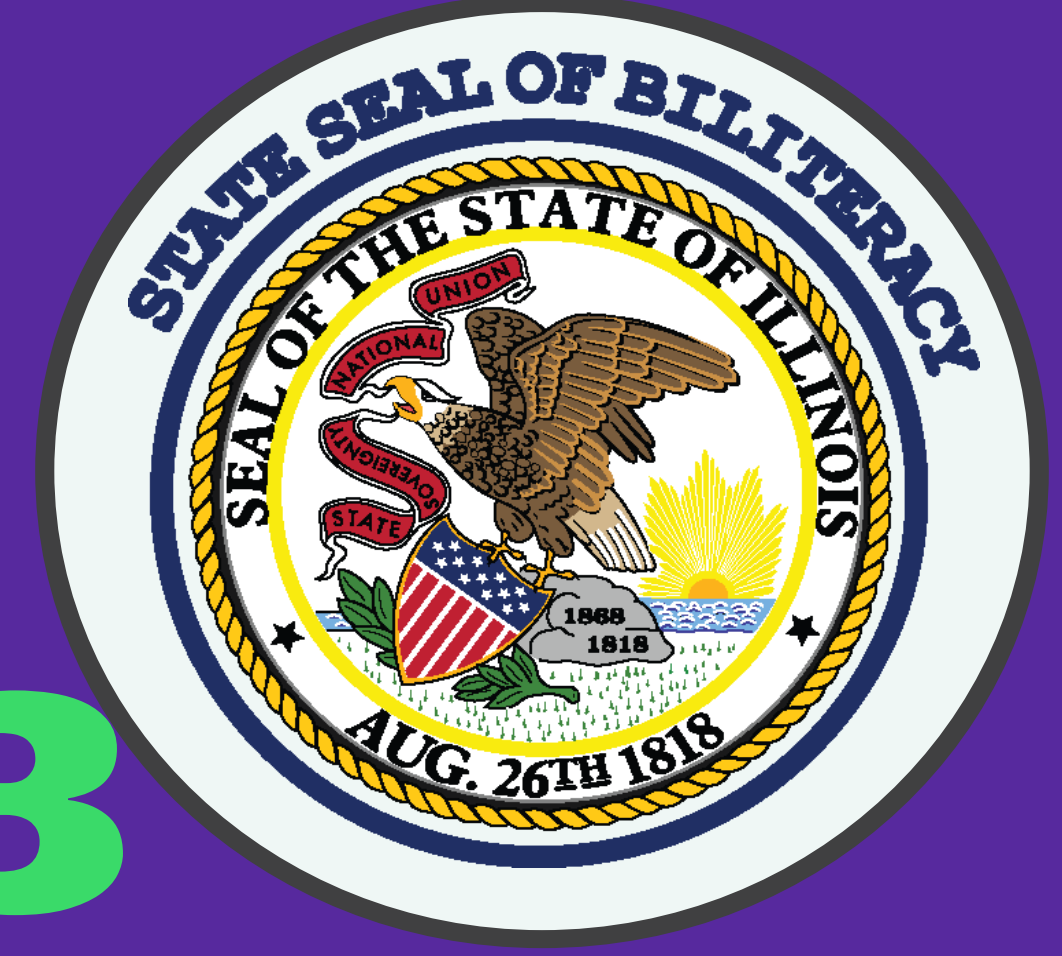

Seals of Biliteracy earned by the **Class of 2024, 35 more** than the Class of 2023!

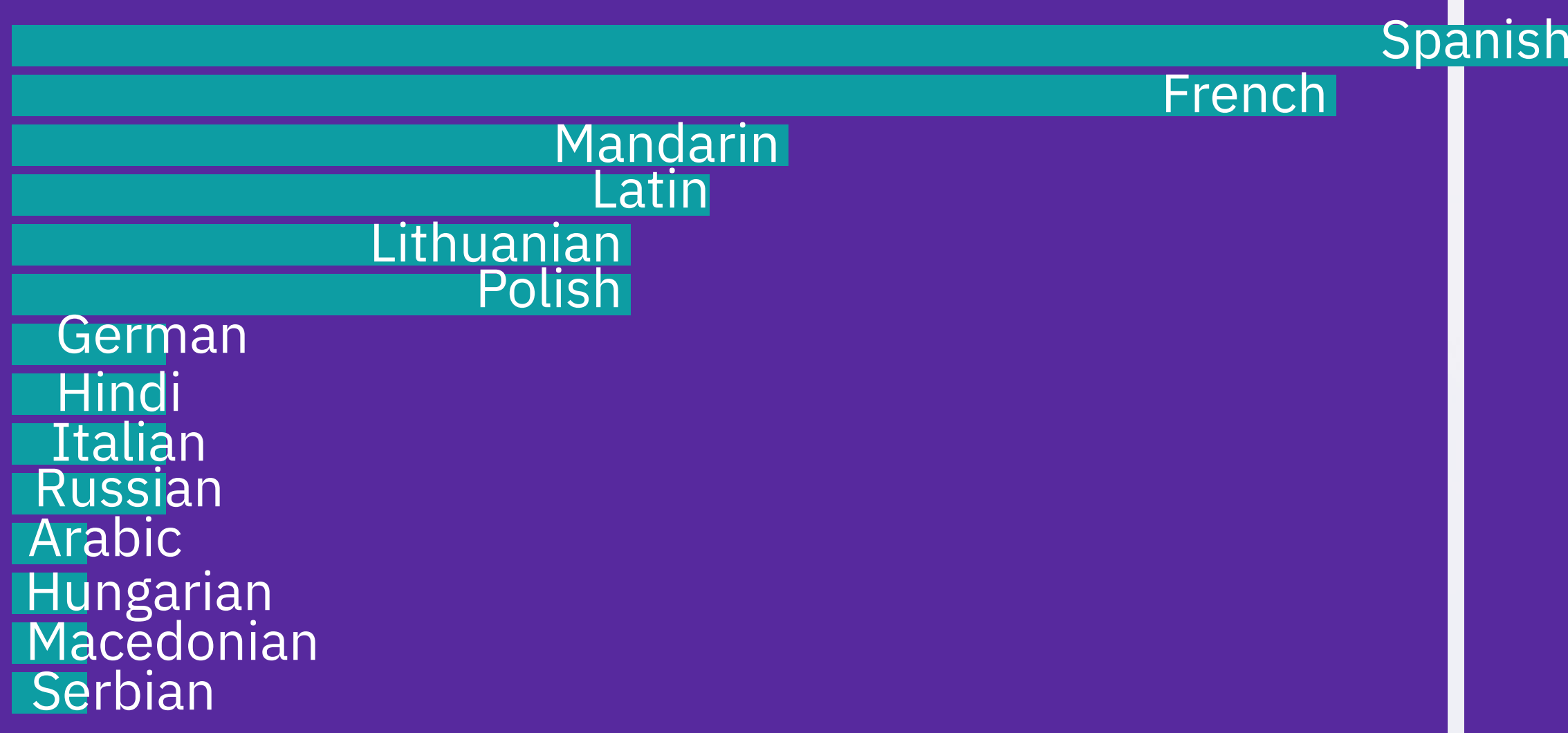

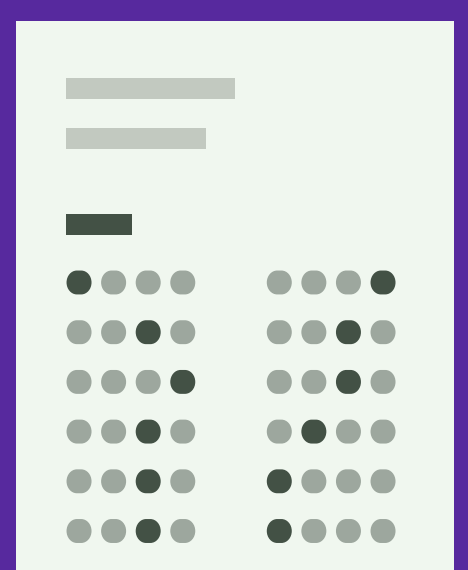


The state of Illinois awarded **7,959 Seals of Biliteracy** across **51 languages** in **114 school districts** to the Class of 2023. (ISBE Seal Data 2023)



3 times

each school year - once on the Fall testing date and twice each Spring (Feb/Mar). *Students can also qualify for the Seal with a 4 or 5 on an AP world language test.*
