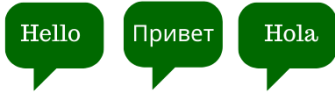


Mission: The Parent Advisory Committee established the school's mission in February of 1999. The community of Olive Grove Elementary School has the shared responsibility to:
