Gifted Testing & Placement -

Students are assessed in three areas (Verbal, Quantitative & Nonverbal) using the CogAT assessment and/or the NGAT. Legend Springs offers gifted services for students who score at or above the **97**th percentile which is recognized as **Gifted** by Arizona. Our **Talent Pool** students who score between **94**th-**96**th percentiles are eligible to receive gifted services at Legend Springs. Placement testing is conducted three times a year on teacher and parent recommendations. Students may also qualify based on other state approved gifted identification assessments. Students may only be <u>tested</u> once per calendar year.
