Wildcat Spotlight—Little Wildcats-Ashlyn Hoffman

Ashlyn gave an overview of the Little Wildcat program. The program provides childcare for any GJCS staff member. Children ages 8 weeks to 5 years old (PreK) are allowed in the program. The program is split in four rooms.

- Little Freshman-8 weeks to 12 months
- Little Sophomores-12 months to 24 months
- Little Juniors-24 months to 47 months (not 3 by August 1st)
- Little Seniors-3 years old (Preschool) and 4 years old (PreK)

This year a curriculum was bought with lesson plans to meet the kids needs.

Mrs. Hoffman informed the Board who the staff are and what area they help with. She also stated the high school helpers who come in are wonderful.

Mrs. Schmidt asked if they hold grandparents' day.

Mrs. Hoffman stated they did, and 49 grandparents attended.

Dr. Englert asked if there is a max for each room.

Mrs. Hoffman stated yes and listed the numbers allowed.

Mr. Lukemeyer stated if there are more children for the one room what happens.

Dr. Lorey stated the child cannot attend unless of an opening. She stated the state dictates the ratio of teachers to students.

Dr. Lorey stated they offer high-quality care. She also stated the program is affordable.

Mrs. Hoffman stated they follow the school calendar for days the kids can attend.

Dr. Lorey asked approval of the 2025 Budget per the budget timeline adopted by the Board earlier this year. All advertising requirements have been met and the public hearing was conducted on August 26th with no questions or remonstrators. There are no changes to the originally proposed budget. She asked approval of the Budget Form 4 and Bus Replacement, CPF, Expenditure Goals, Budget Hearing, Education to Operations Transfer, Rainy Day Transfer, and Budget Transfer Resolutions. Also, she stated that the Education Fund transfer to the Operations Fund does not exceed the statutory 15% threshold. A motion by Arlet Jackle, second by Steve Lukemeyer, to approve the 2025 Budget, was unanimously approved by the Board.

Building & Maintenance Update—Mr. Stenftenagel

Mr. Stenftenagel informed the Board of the food service equipment replacement projects for Jasper Middle School and Jasper High School. He gave a list of items they will address for the project. At both project sites, there will be some mechanical, electrical, and plumbing work required to the existing construction to provide the proper connections for the new equipment.

The total estimate for hard and soft cost for the projects are as follows:

- Jasper High School Food Service Improvements--\$847,000
- Jasper Middle School Food Service Improvements--\$672,000

Vorndran Associates and Gibraltar Design has submitted their respective proposals to perform design services and develop bid documents as follows:

- Vorndran Design (Food Service Consultant and Design) --\$23,200
- Gibraltar Design (Architectural, Mechanical, Electrical, Plumbing Design)--\$12,500

Mr. Lukemeyer asked if the improvements would be paid for by the Operations Fund.

Dr. Lorey stated no. She stated currently the cafeteria is on a spend down plan. The cafeteria should not have a high balance.

Mr. Stenftenagel stated they will be installed over Christmas break.

Mrs. Jackle stated the tennis courts at Jasper Middle School look nice. She also stated that the project came in under budget which is always good.

Student Support Services and Transportation Update—Mr. Buechlein

Mr. Buechlein asked the Board to approve an addendum for Bus 17 owned by Joanie Wening for the length of the 2024-2025 school year. The addendum may be extended for additional years within the length of the original contract. There was some overcrowding, so Joanie Wening agreed to increase the area of the route to elevate the overcrowding. The additional rate of pay is \$13.75 per day. A motion by Sara Schmidt, second by Dr. Englert to approve the addendum for Bus 17, was unanimously approved by the Board.

Other Business:

Dr. Lorey asked the Boad to approve the School Improvement Plans. The Board received each School's Improvement Plan for the 2024-2025 school year. All plans were updated to reflect current data and information. The goals for each school indicate areas for growth and improvement. The majority of the goals are centered around literacy with an attendance goal added to Jasper Middle school. A motion by Steve Lukemeyer, second by Sara Schmidt, to approve the School Improvement Plans, was unanimously approved by the Board.
