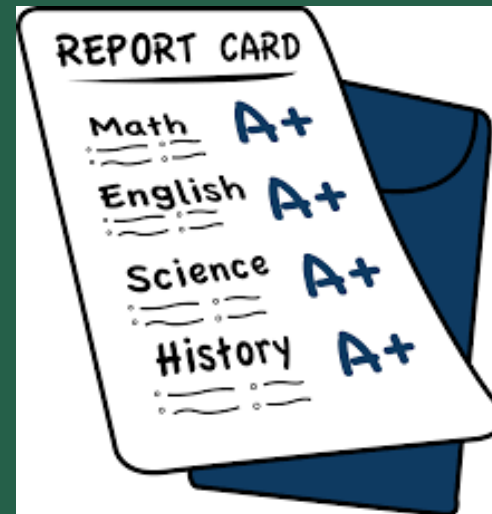
Requirements for a Saint John's diploma are over those set by the State of Maryland

# Support at SJCP

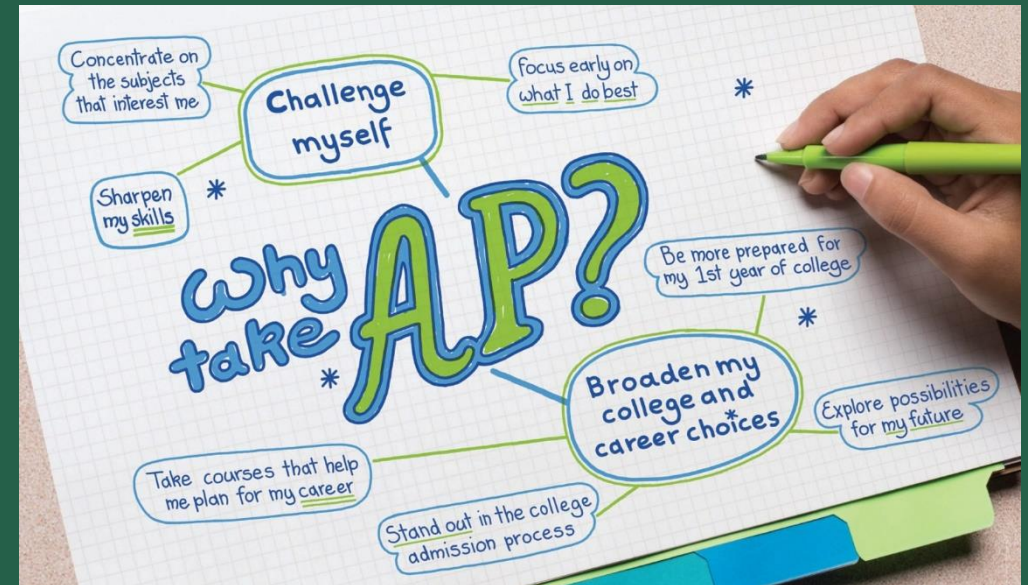
Every day after school:

- Individual teacher tutoring from 2:45-3:45
- PREP Center- for organizational help, project planning, study skills, homework help
- Writing Lab- help on writing assignments in any subject
- NHS peer tutoring- students who have excelled in subject areas available to help other students
- Academic Support meetings - half hour meeting with Mrs. Ryczko our Director of Academic Support



# Honors & Advanced Placement Courses

- We have college prep and Honors classes
- A student can move levels in subjects throughout the years
- A student may be stronger in one area than another- Math vs. English
- We offer 18-20 AP classes- some available in sophomore year with teacher approval
- AP exams in May to earn college credit
- Other honor courses available :
  - Dual Enrollment- MSM
  - Foreign Language 3<sup>rd</sup> year and 4<sup>th</sup> year





# AOPA Program



- This program provides the foundation for advanced exploration in the areas of flying and unmanned aircraft systems, i.e. drones
- Students learn about the engineering process, problem solving, and the innovations and technological developments that have made today's aviation and aerospace industries possible.
- Cohort every other year- will start a new one next year
- 3-4 year program- with a capstone project at the end



# Dual Enrollment



In Senior year 2 college credit options:

- 4 Mount St Mary's classes at the Frederick Campus – 12 credits
  - Students invited based on GPA- (varies from year to year)
  - Can take 2 or 4 classes
  - Second half of the day on SJCP campus to complete required courses
- Senior/Freshman initiative at Emmitsburg campus
  - Students are invited to apply based on academic performance (GPA), interest, and recommendation
  - Can earn up to 30 college credits
  - Still considered a freshman applicant for the next academic year
  - No classes here at SJCP/still can attend activities
