

Apply for the Fall 2024 Dual Enrollment Program



Dual enrollment allows students the option to take LA Pierce College courses while attending ECR. Students experience the college environment, can earn up to 31 (CSU/UC) transferable college credits, & count towards high school graduation. Enrollment fees are waived for K-12 students who complete the steps for Dual Enrollment.

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WHO:
All high school students; priority is given to Juniors and Seniors| 3.0 GPA recommended

WHEN:
Classes begin August 26, 2024 through December 2024

WHERE:
College classes are held at El Camino Real Charter High School in-person during school hours

All students need permission from their School Counselor/Legal Guardian

Students must earn a "C" or higher in college courses to remain in the program

Course Descriptions

COMMS 101- Public Speaking (3 units) UCICSU

Students analyze the theory and techniques of public speaking in a democratic society. Students will discover, develop and critique ideas in public discourse through research, reasoning, organization, composition, presentation and evaluation of various types of speeches including informative and persuasive speeches.

English 101- College Reading & Composition I (3 units) UCICSU

Students gain proficiency in reading and writing through application of the principles of rhetoric and the techniques of critical thinking. A formal research paper is required. An understanding of the elements of grammar, punctuation, and sentence structure is crucial to successful completion of English 101.

Math 227- Statistics (4 units) UCICSU

Students learn about averages, variability, graphical techniques, probability, hypothesis testing, sampling, estimation, correlation, prediction, and linear regression. The emphasis of Math 227 is on the collection and analysis of data and how inferences about a population are made from a sample.

SOC 001- Introduction to Sociology (3 units) UCICSU

Students are introduced to the discipline of sociology through examining its main theoretical and research approaches, and applying them to a variety of social phenomena. Students analyze issues including social interaction, culture, social structure, deviance, social inequality, and social institutions.

El Camino Real Charter High School Dual Enrollment Program

Dear students and parents/guardians,

The Dual Enrollment Program is a two-year program and requires students to commit to taking two Pierce College classes each semester including a Summer. During the Fall and Spring semesters, these classes will be offered during the school day and be part of the student's ECR class schedule. Upon completion of the program, students can earn up to 31 transferable semester units of college coursework.

- **This program is a two-year commitment**
- **The program requires the student to take two Pierce classes each semester**
- **There is no mixing/matching;the student cannot do only one class and not the other**
- **All classes are UC/CSU transferable**
- **Student must pass classes with "C" or better to continue in program**
- **Sample schedule:**
 - **Period 1 - Period 4 (ECR classes)**
 - **Period 5 - Period 6 (Pierce classes that are offered on the ECR campus)**
