LEE COUNTY STUDENTS CONTINUE TO SHOW IMPROVEMENT ON ACT

Leesburg, GA -- Lee County School System students continue to show improvement on their performance on the American College Test (ACT) test, one of the nation's standardized tests used for college admissions, and once again, outperformed their national counterparts.

Reported scores are from the 2023-2024 school year and are a reflection of Lee County High School's tenth, eleventh and twelfth grade students who took the national test in preparation for college submissions. The ACT, like its Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) counterpart, is a nationally standardized test typically used as a part of the college admissions process; however, there are four subjects tested on the ACT – English Language Arts, Math, Reading, and Science – compared to just Math and Evidence-based Reading and Writing with the SAT. Students can score up to a 36 on the ACT in any of the tested areas, and the overall composite score is based on a maximum of 36 as well.

Lee County students' composite score, in comparison to the previous school year, continued to increase and students showed improvement in every tested subject area. Lee County students outperformed their national peers in the composite of measured subject areas.
