Worthington Steel in partnership with local high schools, offers **The Worthington Steel Workforce Experience (WSWE)** – a 14-week, pre-apprenticeship program designed to give interested seniors the opportunity to discover careers in the manufacturing industry. The WSWE program, established in 2021, offers both classroom and hands-on training, with the potential for participants to join our full-time team upon completion.

IN CLASS & ON-THE-JOB LEARNING

Worthington Steel will work to educate students by combining career readiness skills training, in areas such as safety, communications, finance and problem solving, with hands-on techniques they will use in their day-to-day work. Some of the classroom sessions include:

- **Job Instruction Training**
- **Communication Skills**
- **Relationship Building and Teamwork**
- **Business Professionalism**
- **LEAN (Manufacturing) Thinking**

Students will also spend time working on the production floor. We incorporate a paid Production Associate internship as a part of this curriculum. Students go to work during the school year and learn the






same skills as our entry level employees. Aligned with Our Philosophy, guided by the **Golden Rule**, WSWE participants complete a community involvement project to practice good citizenship and give back.
