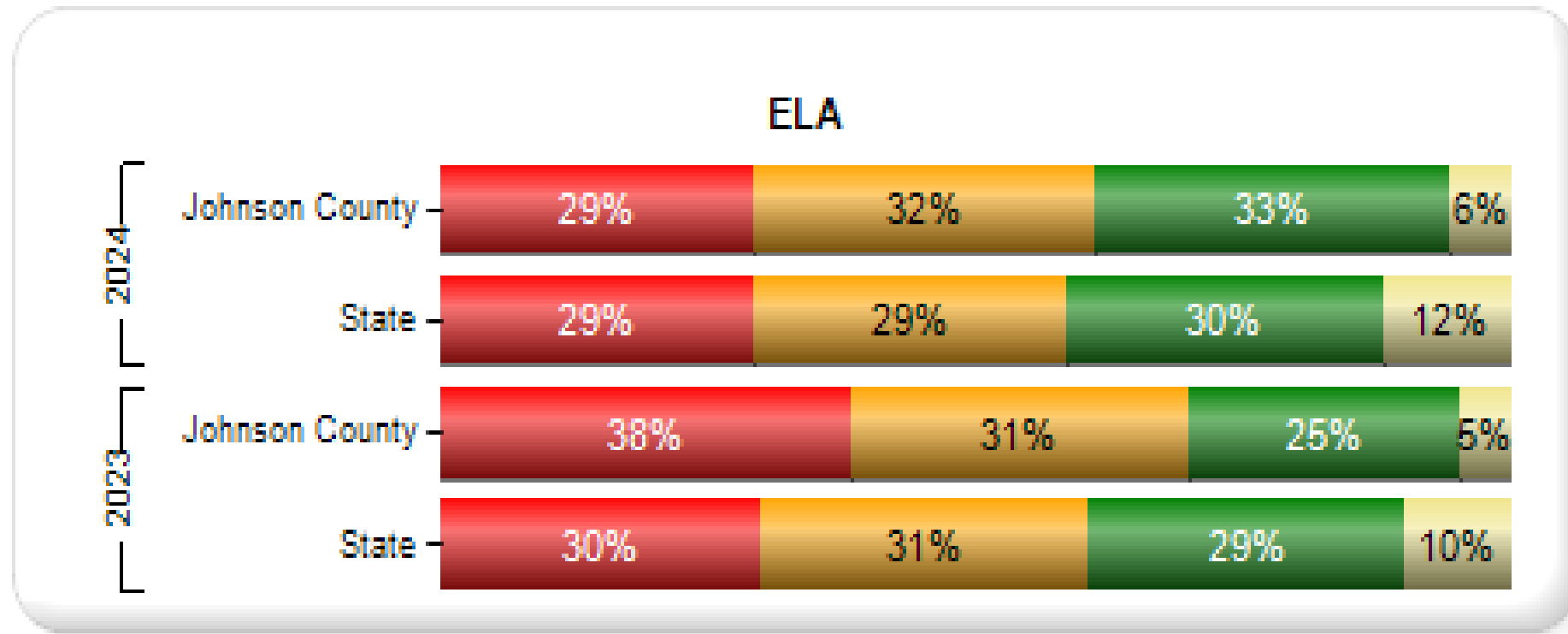

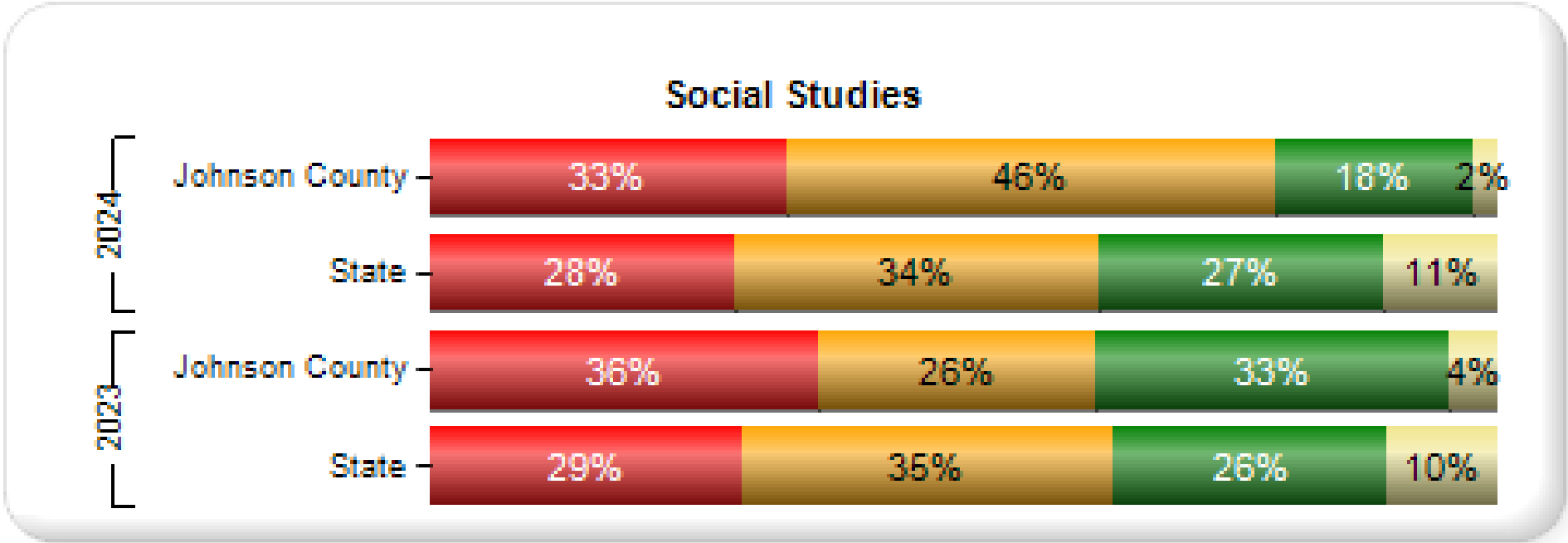
# DISTRICT MATH MILESTONES EOG RESULTS



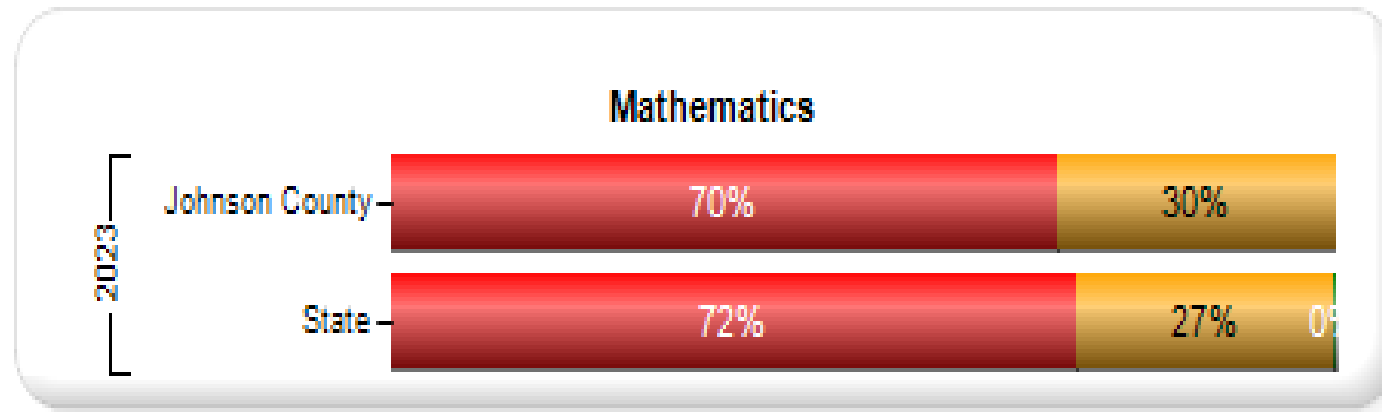
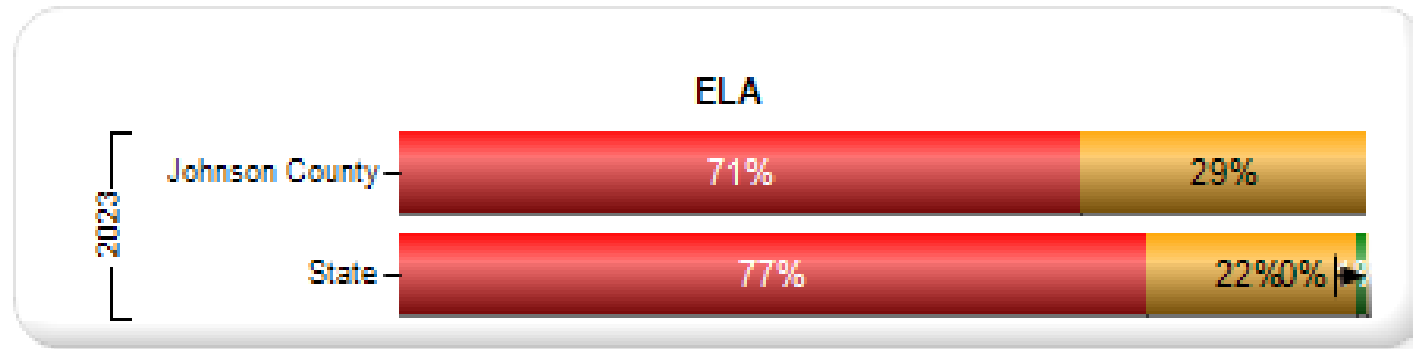

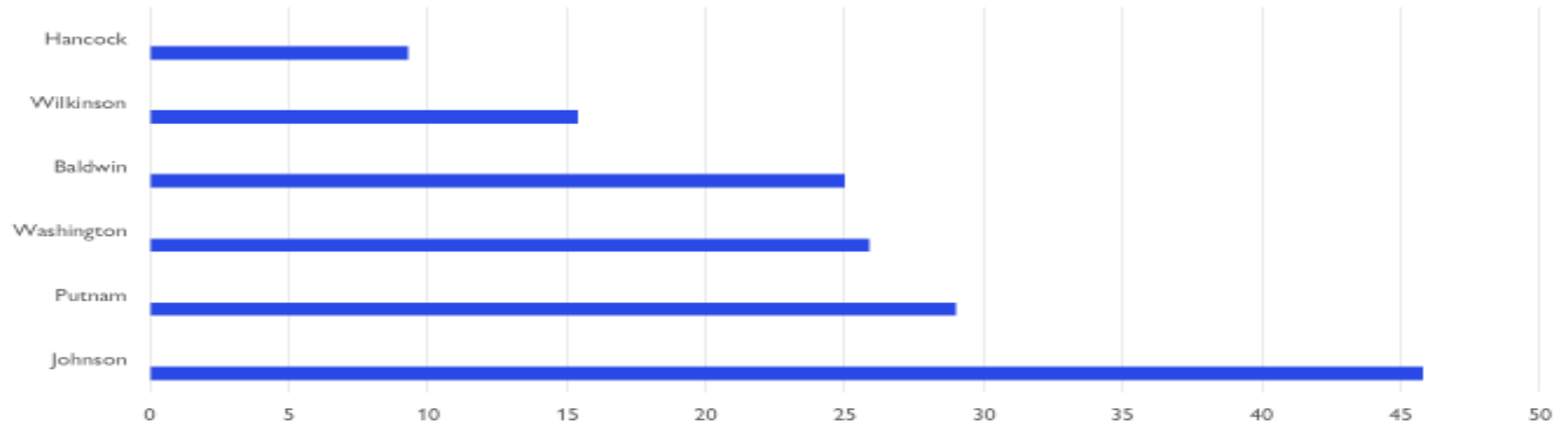

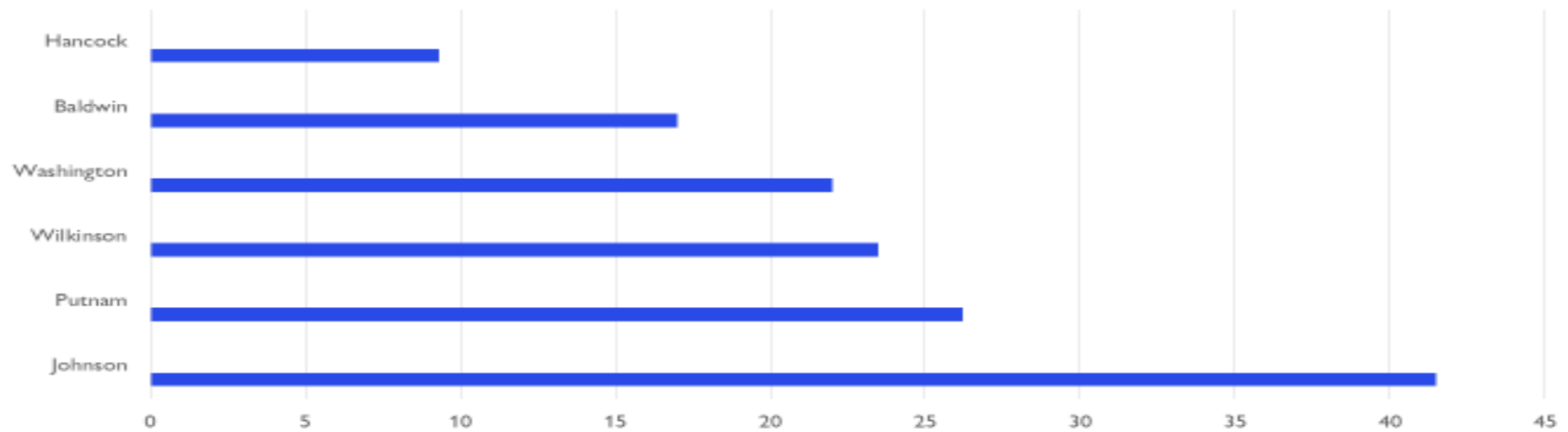

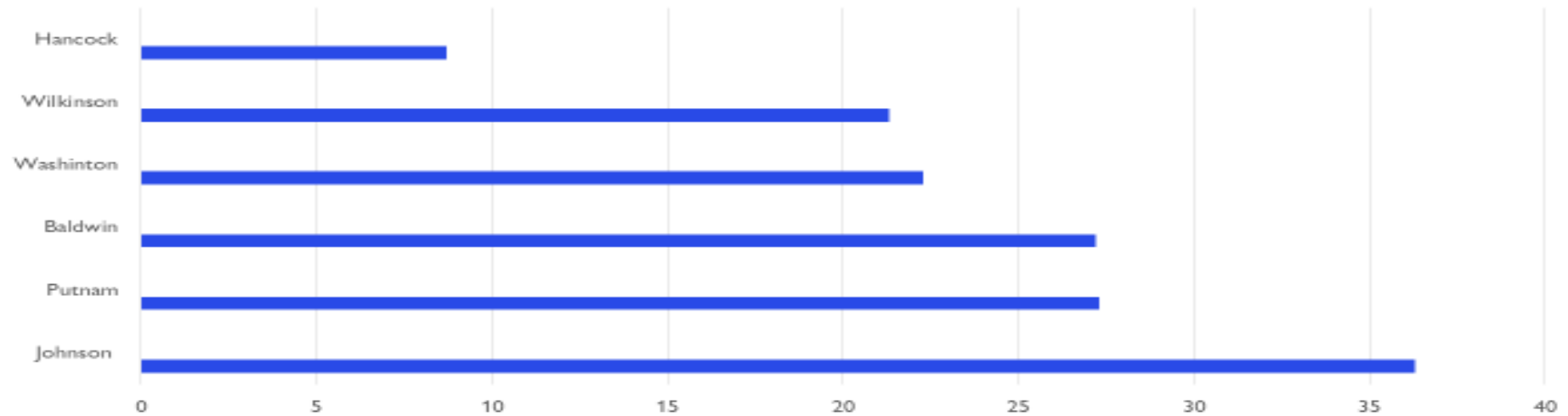

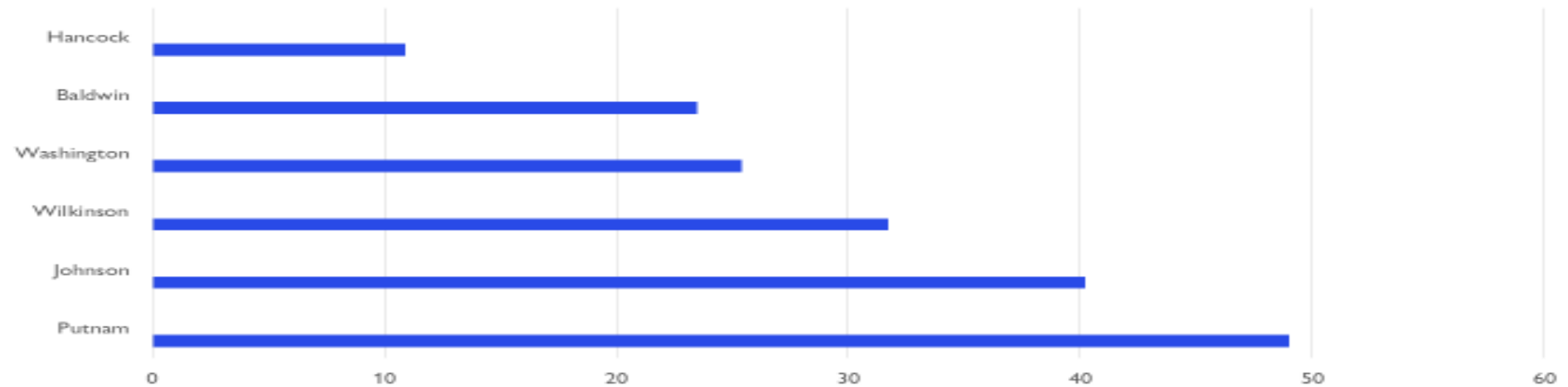

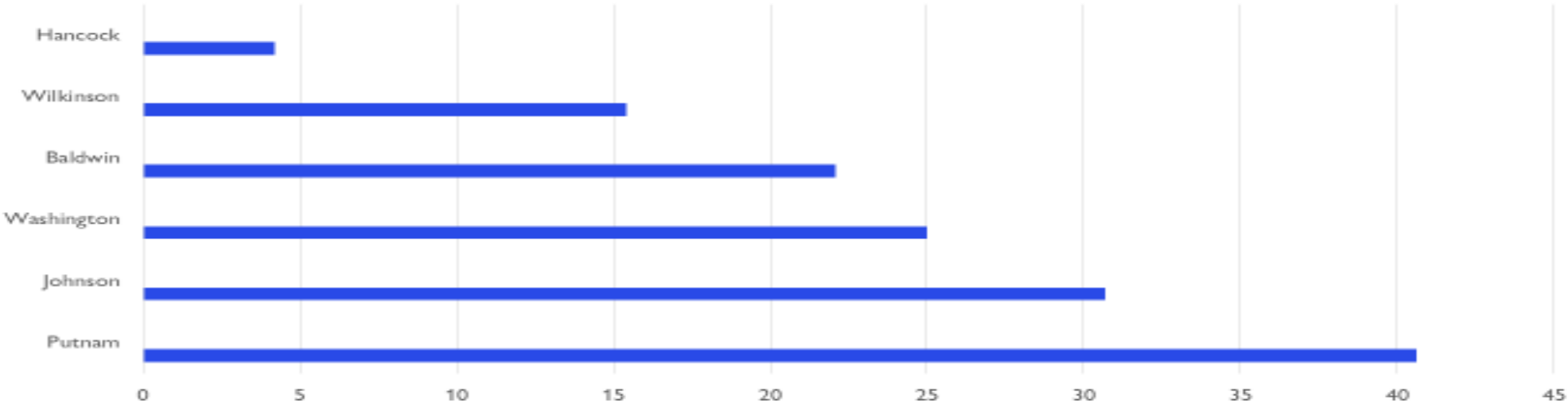

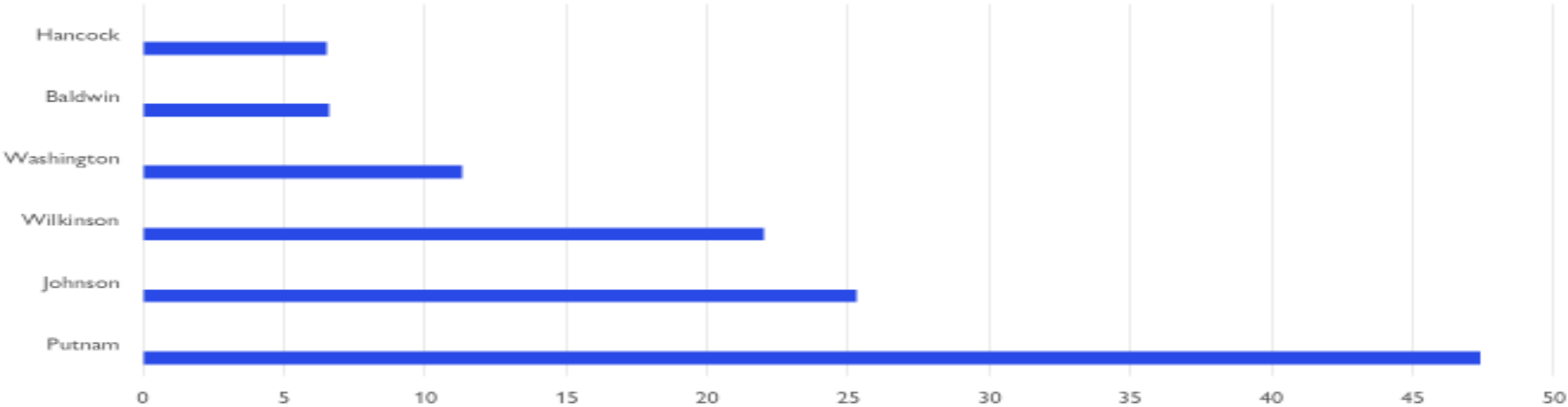

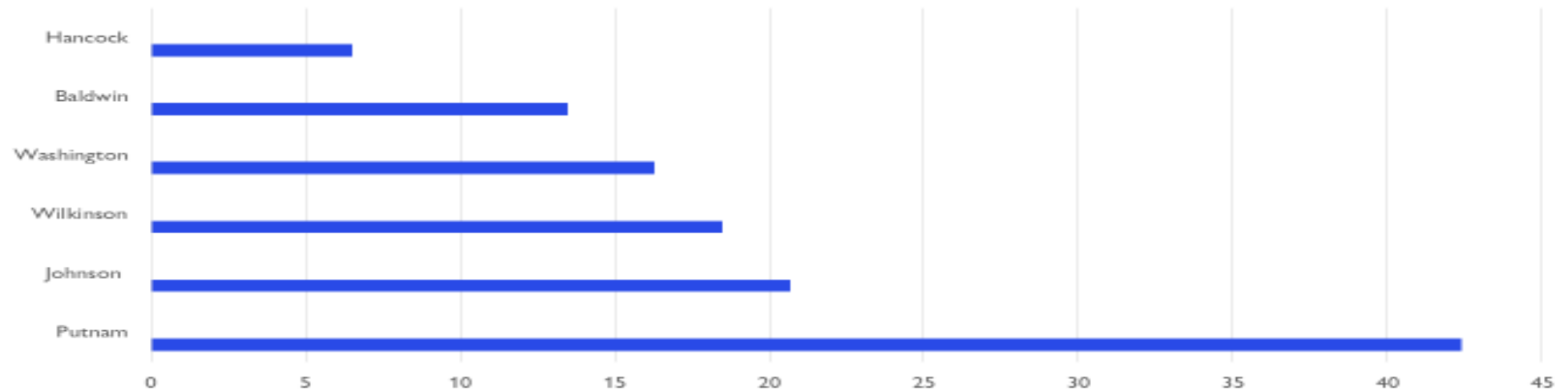
