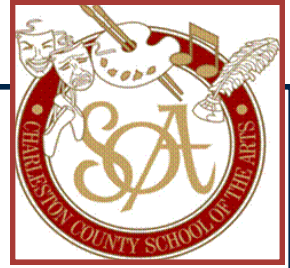


# Choice Application for the 2025-2026 School Year

## 6th—12th Grade Visual Art Audition Requirements

Students must be passing all academic subjects to apply to SOA



### Visual Art Audition

#### Prior to the In-Person Audition

##### 6th—10th Grade

1. Students will need to prepare a portfolio consisting of four (4) works of art created within the past year with at least one created outside of school. You will need to take a picture of these and be prepared to upload them into a Google form (link below).
  - Three of the pieces must include a portrait, still life and landscape. TWO of these MUST be drawn from real life.
  - The fourth piece can be the student's choice. **No cartoons or anime are allowed.**
  - Artworks must represent at least two art mediums. Mediums include, but not limited to: pencil, pen & ink, acrylic, oil, water color, pastel, charcoal sculpture or ceramic.
  - Cartoons and anime will not be accepted and scored.
2. You will upload your child's portfolio into a Google form (linked below). You will fill out the form with the student's first name only, grade applying for and School Choice ID# (will be sent to you), the dimensions in inches of the piece, and the medium used for the picture.

##### 11th—12th Grade

1. Students will need to prepare a portfolio consisting of four (4) works of art created within the past year with at least one created outside of school. You will need to take a picture of these and be prepared to upload them into a Google form (link below).
  - Three of the pieces must be connected by a theme or idea. You will need to write a paragraph that identifies the theme or idea and how the three pieces are driven by it.
  - The remaining piece can be the student's choice. **No cartoons or anime are allowed.**
  - Artworks must represent at least two art mediums. Mediums include, but not limited to: pencil, pen & ink, acrylic, oil, water color, pastel, charcoal sculpture or ceramic.
  - Cartoons and anime will not be accepted and scored.
2. You will upload your child's portfolio into a Google form (linked below). You will fill out the form with the student's first name only, grade applying for and School Choice ID# (will be sent to you), the dimensions in inches of the piece, and the medium used for the picture.

#### For the Onsite Drawing Test

1. Students will schedule a drawing test date and time when filling out the online School Choice application.
2. Pencils, paper, eraser and sharpener will be provided.
3. The onsite drawing test will be turned in to the teachers at the end of the 30 minute timed session. Your child's first name, grade applying for and their School Choice ID number will be placed on the sheet used for the drawing test. This sheet will be given to your child at the start of the audition.
