Track

The year 1950-51 in the annals of Medford high track may well be termed the Year of Inches. Paced by their co-captains, John LeComte and Ronald Beard, the varsity tracksters of Coach Henry D. Hormel just missed having one of the greatest seasons in MHS dual meet history. The elusive one-point margin made the difference in three of the meets and one was decided by but two points.

Watertown, titlists of the Met League in 1949-50 were the first victims of the Mustang trackmen in a $39\frac{1}{2}$ - $37\frac{1}{2}$ meet that kept the spectators in doubt as to the winner until the relays were run. Co-captain Johnny LeComte tied the 300-yard record, in this contest. The Arlington dual affair, another one-pointer 39-38, favor of MHS, had the same down-to-the-last-event interest as the opener. John McGrath again took high jumping honors and Co-Captain Ron Beard came home winner in the 600 yard run again, while Co-captain Johnny LeComte nipped the 300 yard record.

In the outside meets the Mustangs scored a signal victory in the Northeasterns when LeComte defeated the favored state 440 champ in the 300 yard dash with the blazing fast time of 33.6 seconds. In the State meet, Ron Beard anchored the relay team to a fourth place



among some exceptionally fast quartets from all over the state. All in all it added up to a great year, one that could have been even greater but for an inch or two.

The Cooperative Office Training Course is offered to senior girls who wish to obtain a more complete knowledge of the business world than the classroom affords. To qualify for this class, girls must have above-average grades, good attendance records, favorable recommendations from teachers, and the signed permission of their parents.

The class is divided into two groups which work on a two-week alternating schedule. One group reports for work in business offices while the second attends school; then, the positions are reversed. The girls receive the regular starting salary and are carefully supervised while at work. Employers send rating sheets to the school pointing out the girls' abilities and deficiencies, which enables the school to give special attention and instruction to correct each girl's weak points. This working experience not only offers the girls sound, practical business knowledge, but it also gives them the opportunity to learn the grooming and personality traits which are so much a part of the successful business girl.

Much credit for the success of this new type of program is due to the tireless efforts of the class advisor, Miss Roughsedge. Thanks to Miss Roughsedge and the girls of her Cooperative Office Training Class, Medford High continues to lead the schools of this area in the field of business education.

The Girls' Distributive Education Class has enrolled in its membership twenty senior girls who were selected because of their special aptitude for this type of work — relating. This is the ninth class to be graduated from our Distributive Education Course.

The subjects studied by this group are: retail selling, merchandise information, economics of retailing, store organization, store arithmetic, color, line and design, fashion, advertising and display. The members of a D. E. Class receive valuable work experience each day, and on Saturday working in department stores, and specialty shops. The retailers who hire our girls on this training program are most enthusiastic, and are anxious to cooperate because many of the girls become potential candidates for buyers' positions and for display and advertising positions in their stores.

The class is closely supervised in the stores by the supervisors of the Training Departments and also by their Teacher-Co-ordinator, Mary Isabelle McKay. The class "earns while it learns" and most of our girls earn as much as \$700.00 in a school year.

The boys' cooperative work program in Distributive Education entered its second year with an enrollment of 21 boys.

Under the instruction of their teacher-co-ordinator, J. Walter Langley, the students covered the following subject material: Economics of Retailing (store mathematics, store system, store organization and management); Sales techniques (retail selling, advertising and display); and Merchandise Information (Textiles and non-Textiles). They also received instruction in related English, Hygiene and Physical Education.

In addition to their school work the boys are privileged to work in stores in the afternoon and evening hours for which they get school credit as well as being paid the prevailing wage for part-time employment. This enables the student to put into practical use the instruction that he receives in the classroom. Upon graduation, if he has proven himself a good worker, he is in a position to accept full-time employment on that job through mutual agreement with his employer.

During the school year, his work on the job is closely observed by the teacher-coordinator who confers with the employer periodical-ly in an effort to correct any apparent weaknesses which might prevent him from being successful at his work. Through the cooperative effort of the school and employer, therefore, the student stands a better chance of advancing in his chosen work.

Distributive Education - Boys'
