The senior athletes of the club receive "M" sweaters because of the success of the "M" club dances and the Talent Show put on by the various talented students each year.

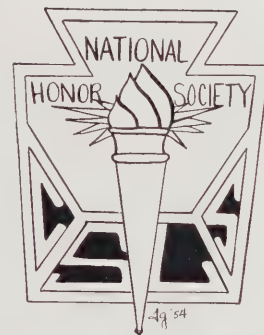

Projector Club



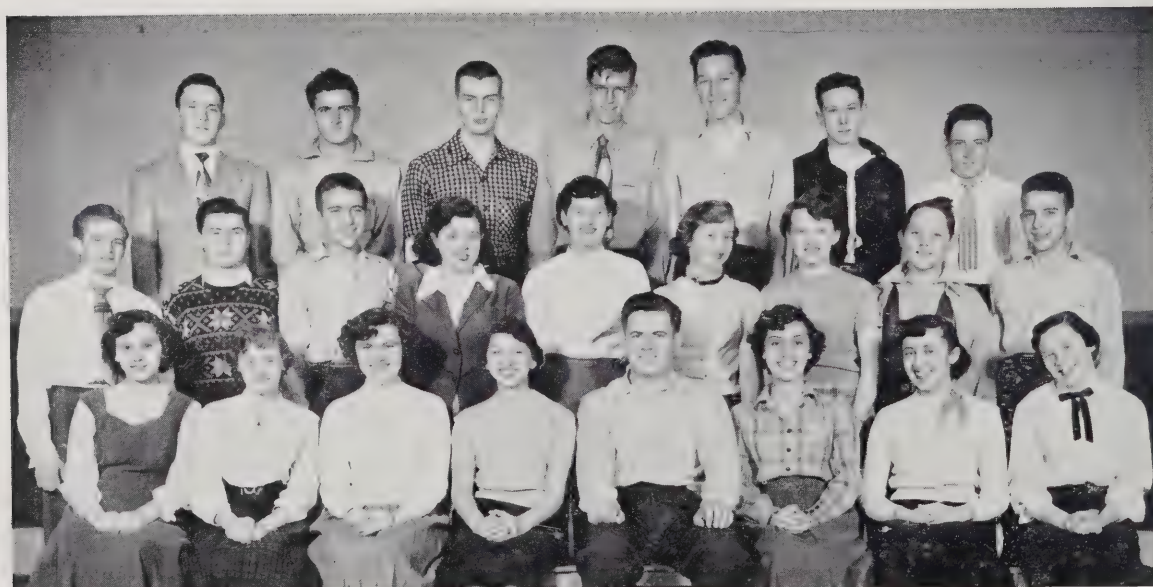

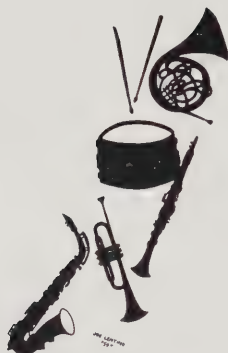
All-Girl Choir

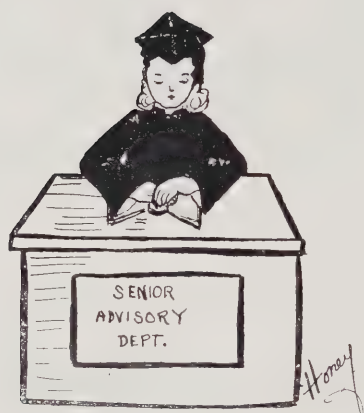

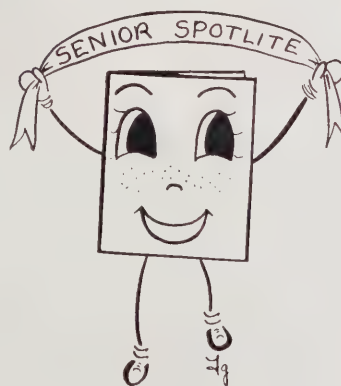

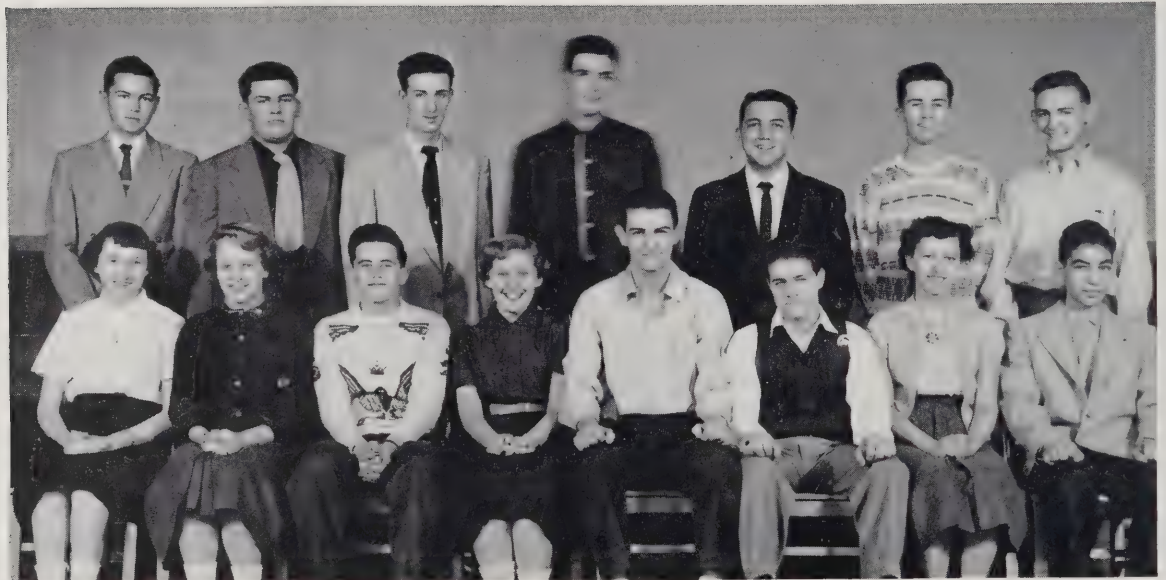


Student Cabinet

The president is Philip Shaw, and the secretary is Barbara Bugden. Mr. Henry Hormel is the advisor.





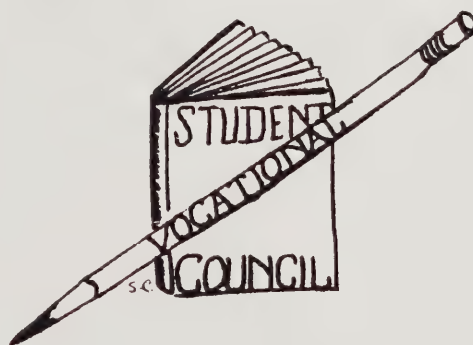
Vocational Student Council

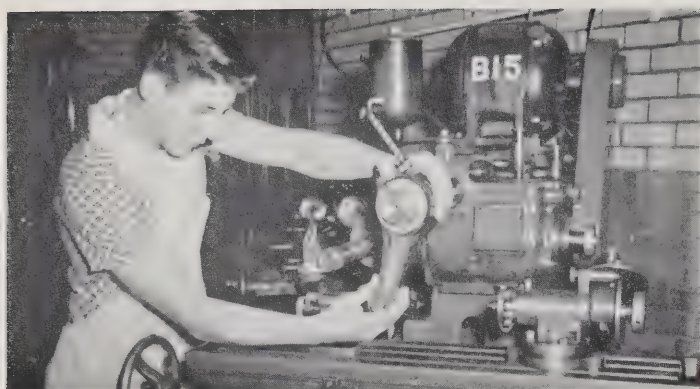
