Students may receive a waiver of this requirement from the Vice Principal of Academics if an irreconcilable schedule conflict exists and they complete an alternate skill-development activity.

REQUIREMENTS

- Return Students: Submit Return Form by January 31
- New Applicants: Submit Application by March 15
- Cumulative weighted academic GPA of 3.00 or higher
- Complete 125 hours of internship by March of senior year
- Attend field trips and conferences
- Participate in evening lectures/labs
- Annual fee of \$550

No refunds will be given after the application is submitted unless the application is not accepted.
