St. Margaret Mary Alacoque (1647-1690) reported visions of Jesus Christ directing her to promote devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus on nine consecutive First Fridays in reparation for sins and to show love to Jesus. We pray your family continues this devotion at your Parish community.

## First Friday Promises of the Sacred Heart of Jesus

- I will give them all the graces necessary in their state of life.
  - I will establish peace in their homes.
  - I will comfort them in all their afflictions.
  - I will be their secure refuge during life, and above all, in death.
  - I will bestow abundant blessings upon all their undertakings.
  - Sinners will find in my Heart the source and infinite ocean of mercy.
