Closed November 11 for Veteran's Day and November 28 for Thanksgiving as well as closing at 5 pm on Thanksgiving Eve.



Yes, we still have DVDs at the library! Streaming video has become very important to people in our community, but there are still folks who prefer watching series and movies on DVD. An average of 871 DVDs are checked out every month, some from our own collection and others ordered through interlibrary loan from other libraries. We have just streamlined our checkout process for DVDs and now patrons can take 10 DVDs out at a time! These videos circulate for one week, but will auto renew for another week if there are no holds on the item. The industry has changed in the last few years and unfortunately some movies that we'd like to circulate are unavailable on DVD (such as Boys in the Boat). Sometimes it also takes quite a while for movies to be released on DVD after they have been streaming or in the cinema. We are a member of a library consortium with over 80 libraries, so if you'd like to see an older movie (usually not available to stream) we can generally find it for you and have it sent here.

We are happy to be able to accommodate non-profit community groups in our program rooms. The library is open until 8 pm Monday through Thursday, which gives the opportunity for all kinds of groups to meet in our comfortable, versatile rooms. A new addition to the library in the last month is a chess club that meets on Tuesday evenings from 4:30-7:30. They are looking for new players, so if you're interested feel free to drop in and play!
